Promoting fitness in the workplace, friendly competition between teams and **camaraderie among fellow employees**, the Chase Corporate Challenge is like no other event! Join the Cat Crew...walkers, runners, coworkers, and those who just want to be part of a very fun and exciting experience. Landmarks along the race route include Lake Shore Drive, Buckingham Fountain, and Lake Michigan. Social time before and after the race is as rewarding as walking or running the spectacular course!

The Cat Crew will participate in the 2013 Chicago Chase Corporate Challenge, along with over 23,000 employees from 600+ companies. Last year the Cat Crew included employees from Aurora, Decatur, Des Plaines, Downers Grove, Joliet, Lafayette, Peoria-area (9 facilities), Pontiac, and San Diego – and was awarded the 4th largest team with over 250 participants.

The Corporate Challenge event includes a 3.5-mile road race for **runners and walkers** sponsored by JPMorgan Chase with similar road races held around the world – in 13 cities in seven countries on five continents – in total over 248,000 employees participating from 8,000+ companies. The Corporate Challenge celebrates teamwork. Unlike other road races, individuals cannot enter – only if their company is entered. The goal is to bring companies and their employees together in a healthy, camaraderie-filled environment for a fun night. Employees of a company are scored as a team and compete against other corporate teams.

Cat Crew shirts and bus transportation (from Peoria and possibly other facilities) are offered along with a Cat Crew tent located in Grant Park to gather before and after the race, with dinner at the conclusion of the race. *Even if you don't want to run or walk the race, signup to be part of this awesome experience. If you need a buddy to run or walk with, just let us know.*

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Race Participants (Employees only):

- Caterpillar <u>employees</u>: JPMorgan Chase Corporate Challenge rules state participants must be actively employed by Caterpillar, working at least 25 hrs/wk for at least 3 months prior to race day, and 18 years of age. Retirees, temporary employees, family members, employees on leave, and sub-contractors/agency/leased workers are not eligible to participate.
- Registration: Each runner/walker MUST 1st register and <u>pay online</u> at the Caterpillar Social Activities website https://socialactivities.cat.com. (Under "Events" click on Cat Crew Chase Corporate Challenge and read the registration instructions.) Follow the steps on the online system including payment to register with the Cat Crew.

After completing the Cat Crew online registration, each runner/walker MUST 2nd register for the event (in order to get a race bib & #) at www.jpmorganchasecc.com.

- If you fail to register at the Caterpillar Social Activities website 1st OR fail to register on both sites, your registration will be cancelled with no refunds.
