

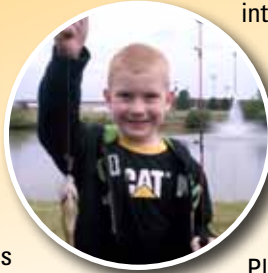

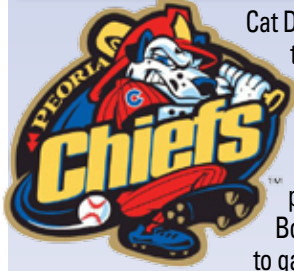

CAT DAY with the PEORIA CHIEFS – Sunday, June 9



Cat Day with the Peoria Chiefs for employees, retirees, and their families will be Sunday, June 9, at 5 p.m. when the Peoria Chiefs take on the Quad Cities River Bandits at Peoria Chiefs Stadium. Gates open at 4 p.m. The first 1,500 children (ages 12 and under) through the gates will receive a Peoria Chiefs / Caterpillar mini bat. In addition, the Caterpillar Employees Mixed Chorus will be performing the National Anthem to kick off the game.

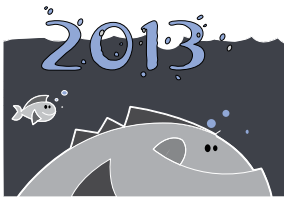
