Transfer Stations

Visibility, durability, reliability, maneuverability and flexibility are all key elements of any machine working in a transfer station.

Wheel loaders, due to their high lift and dump capability, are the best choice for keeping transfer stations organized by stockpiling material and loading trucks or hoppers. Compact loaders and skid steer loaders work well in sorting and tight spaces. These machines can also be mounted with angle broom and sweeper collector work tools to clean debris. Excavators aid in material sorting and loading haul vehicles.

Some excavators feature hydraulic cab risers, simplifying cab entry and exit and offering operators a better view of the work area.
