Basketball League Registration Meeting – October 29

The Registration Meeting for Caterpillar employees and retirees to register teams for recreational basketball will be held on Wednesday, October 29, beginning at 4:30 p.m. in the Administration Building's conference room SL-D (Service Level - D Wing). Employees not badged for the Administration Building will need to check in at the Security Office on Washington Street.

Caterpillar employees, retirees, and their spouses are eligible to participate.

The team captain (or assigned representative) must attend the mandatory Registration Meeting to submit the team registration form and check or money order made payable to Caterpillar Inc. for \$125. No cash please. Registration is by team - not individual players.

Leagues begin in early January. Team player names are not required for the meeting.

Individual players who do not have a team organized may e-mail socialactivities@cat.com with name and telephone number before October 27. Names will be given to captains at the meeting and individuals will be contacted by the captains if players are needed.

To create your own team, gather coworkers and send a Team Captain (or representative) to the Registration Meeting. League rules (including eligibility) can be found at https://socialactivities.cat.com under Athletic Leagues.

For reference, over the past few years, games have been played Monday through Thursday nights.
