This is a beaver. It uses its big, sharp teeth to demolish (knock down) and haul logs to make its home.

What job can a beaver and grappler do?

Dig Demolish Load



This attachment is called a grappler. It is used to sort materials, haul things, or demolish (knock down) objects.



What job can a ripper and a badger do?

Haul Load Dig



This is a badger. It lives underground and has large claws to break up and move dirt.

This attachment is called a ripper. Sometimes it goes on the back of a tractor to break up dirt.



This is a giraffe. It has a long neck to eat leaves from tall trees.

What job can a giraffe and a telehandler do?

Reach Haul Demolish



This machine is a telehandler. It can extend to high places.
