This attachment is called a ripper. Sometimes it goes on the back of a tractor to break up dirt. What job can a ripper and a badger do?



This is a badger. It lives underground and has large claws to break up and move dirt.



This is a giraffe. It has a long neck to eat leaves from tall trees. What job can a giraffe and a telehandler do?



This machine is a telehandler. It can extend to high places.
