

# Around the Green Golf Scramble 

In its $11^{\text {th }}$ year, the Around the Green Golf Scramble for Caterpillar employees and retirees sold out in less than four weeks with over 500 golfers. The event offered by Caterpillar Social Activities continues to be popular. Golfers have learned to sign up early!
Unlike the rained out event in 2014, the weather was perfect-just as the organizers ordered. At the conclusion of each scramble, golfers socialized and shared stories while enjoying a meal and awards presentation.
Unfortunately no one won the hole-in-one promotions on various holes at the challenging WeaverRidge Golf Course. Event volunteers did witness several close calls-one within 4 inches on hole \# 12—which was for the $\$ 10,000$ cash prize. High quality golf clubs were awarded to hole promotion winners for straightest drive, longest putt and closest to the pin.
Altogether, the event offered promotions on 11 of the 18 holes. In addition, door prizes were awarded at the ceremony following each golf session and a drawing
 for an indoor-size bag toss game which included all golfers who registered online for the event. Cash prizes were awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place foursome winners in 3 flights for a total of 9 foursome winners ( 36 golfers). Keeping with tradition, a free round of golf was presented to the foursome in each session that had the highest score.
