Promoting fitness in the workplace, friendly competition between teams, and camaraderie among fellow employees, the **J.P. Morgan Corporate Challenge** is like no other event! Landmarks along the race route include Lake Shore Drive, Buckingham Fountain, and Lake Michigan. Social time before and after the race is as rewarding as walking or running the spectacular course!

The **Cat Crew** will participate in the 2015 Chicago Corporate Challenge, along with over 25,000 employees from 600+ companies. Last year, the Cat Crew energized 319 employees from 21 facilities including Aurora, Boonville, Burr Ridge, Decatur, Joliet, Lafayette, LaGrange, Oak Creek, Peoria-area (10 facilities), Pontiac, San Diego and South Milwaukee.

The Corporate Challenge event includes a 3.5-mile road race for runners and walkers with similar events held around the world—in 13 cities on five continents—in total over 265,000 employees participating from over 8,000 companies. The Corporate Challenge celebrates teamwork. Participants may only register as part of a company team. The goal is to bring companies and their employees together by promoting health and fitness in the workplace, foster goodwill and camaraderie among their employees, and show their commitment to the community and best environmental practices. Employees of a company are scored as a team and compete against other corporate teams.


Close to You: Music of the Carpenters


