

CAT® D6N AUDIO DOWNLOAD INSTRUCTIONS

- Get the full track to listen to the song over and over
- Set up sound bites from song as ringtones



RINGTONE DOWNLOAD

To download sound bites as a ringtone, the following instructions outline how to sideload files as a ringtone to your phone. You will need a PC, your mobile device and a USB connection.

iPhone

If you have an Apple iPhone, visit www.cat.com/D6Nthankyou on your PC and connect your mobile device.

Download

- Download the M4A file to a directory of your choosing by right clicking the link and selecting Download Link File or Save Link File

Import to iTunes

- Double click the file to open it in iTunes and import it into the Tones library.

Sync to phone

- Plug your iPhone into your computer.
- Click on iPhone.
- Click on tones tab.
- Make sure that the "sync tones" checkbox is checked.
- Click "sync."

Set as ringtone

- Use your iPhone to set the ringtone as you normally would—either as the default ringtone or assigned to a contact.

Android™ Phones

If you have an Android, visit www.cat.com/D6Nthankyou on your PC and connect your mobile device.

Download

- Download the MP3 file to a directory of your choosing by right clicking the link and selecting Download Link File or Save Link File.
- Set the phone to connect as a Disk Drive.
Note: If you are not prompted to "Mount as Disk Drive," check the Android Status Bar and click the USB connection type. Choose "Disk Drive – Mount as Disk Drive" as your connection type.

- On your Desktop, click "My Computer" and find the disk drive associated with your Android phone.
Note: If you see a separate drive for your SD Card, you may use either drive.
- Open the drive and look for a folder labeled "ringtones." If it does not exist, create one now.
- Drag the MP3 file to the "ringtones" folder.
- Safely remove the phone (using "Safely Remove Hardware" for PC or the eject button for Mac) and physically disconnect it to complete the transfer.
- Click "sync."

Set as ringtone

- Use your cell phone to set the ringtone as you normally would – either as the default ringtone or assigned to a contact.

If you have another type of phone, use one of the download instructions below.

Other Phones

Most smartphones can play MP3 files as ringtones. The process for downloading and installing ringtones to a smartphone may vary greatly based on phone, operating system, and service provider. Check your phone's user manual or your provider's website.
