### TOPIC: How To Keep Drivers In Their Cabs

Drivers outside of a cab in loading and unloading areas may be exposed to the variety of hazards that exist on mine property.

#### Prepare for Loading

Make sure drivers complete the following tasks before entering the mine site:

- Clean truck bed.
- Check tires.
- Inspect truck.
- Prepare tarp.

#### Load Properly

- Do not overload trucks.
- Designate dump-off areas for drivers to remove excess material.
- Ensure drivers tarp and trim the load outside of the loading area.
- Stop loading activities if the driver is not in the vehicle.

#### Keep Drivers Safe and Aware

- Before drivers enter mine property, inform them of hazards they may encounter if stepping outside of the cab is necessary.
- If climbing is necessary, ensure drivers use ladders and proper fall protection.
