Signs of Fatigue

- Tiredness
- Falling asleep unwillingly
- Irritability
- Depression
- Loss of appetite

Effects of Fatigue

- Hindered decision-making ability
- Reduced productivity
- Inattentiveness
- Reduced ability to handle stress
- Loss of memory or ability to recall details
- Decreased reaction time

Prevention

- Take frequent breaks for water, rest, and food
- Encourage job rotation to avoid repetition and maintain awareness
- Monitor behavior of co-workers for signs of fatigue, and relieve them whenever possible
- Ensure the availability of adequate time off
- Find a healthy balance between work and personal life
- Become aware of training and counseling opportunities
