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# **Social Activities & Services**

Company-sponsored social activities and services play an important role in the strength and development of every business because they offer employees the opportunity to get to know each other outside of the work environment and at the same time enhance working relationships.

Caterpillar cares about the well-being of its employees, retirees and their families—so the company sponsors the Caterpillar Social Activities Program. The program, which offers a variety of activities and services, helps connect the Caterpillar family by creating opportunities to come together in a relaxed, social environment. The Social Activities program includes activities/events, special interest clubs, athletic leagues, discount tickets, bus trips/excursions and convenience services. The program serves more than 20,000 employees, retirees and their families each year.

To register in the Social Activities offers, you must be an active Caterpillar employee or retiree. For some activities, legal dependents and guests are included. In order to ensure the intended audience (the employee/retiree) is being served, the following criteria have been established.

- Athletic Leagues—Active Caterpillar employees and retirees are eligible to participate. Spouses are eligible to participate if the employee/retiree participates.
- Bus Trips/Excursions—Active Caterpillar employees and retirees are eligible to register. Guests are eligible to participate if they attend with the employee/retiree.
- Clubs—Active Caterpillar employees and retirees are eligible to be members of the employee clubs.

Events—Active Caterpillar employees and retirees are eligible to register. For some events, legal dependents and
grandchildren are eligible to participate as long as the employee/retiree participates. Due to resources available,
other individuals (parents, grandparents, adult children, aunts & uncles, friends visiting from out of town, etc.) are not
eligible to attend. (Event eligibility varies by event and is included on every registration form.)
