











Workflow

This section is an illustration of the workflow associated with the DA. The small red arrow indicates at which of the available phases that the DA has progressed to.



Basic information

Basic information

This section establishes whether or not the DA is an internal DA or a DA initiated by a supplier.

Different fields are available for display or modification depending on whether the DA is a supplier or internal DA.






Supplier DA

This section holds basic supplier information including the name of the supplier representative initiating the DA and other ETQ account information related to the logged in user.
