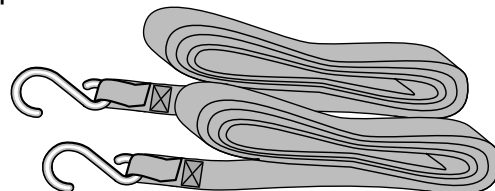
IMPORTANT WARNINGS:

- Adult Use and Installation Only.
- Limit transport distance to 250 miles.
- Limit of one boat per vehicle.
- Weight limit on crossbars is 150 lbs.
- Weight limit on rooftop is provided by the car manufacturer.
- The rear hatch may not fully open when car is loaded with a kayak.
- Antenna on the rooftop may need to be removed when using the carrier kit.
- Remove carrier kit and kayak when entering a car wash.
- All vehicular transports are potentially hazardous. Any person(s) using Quest products are personally responsible for following the given directions for use and/or installation. Quest is not responsible for damage to your vehicle.
- It is critical that all Quest racks and accessories be properly and securely attached to your vehicle. Improper attachment could result in a serious accident, and could cause serious bodily injury or death to you or to others.
- You are responsible for securing the racks and accessories to your car, checking the attachment's prior to use, and periodically inspecting the products for adjustment, wear, and damage.
- You must read and understand all of the instructions and cautions supplied with your Quest products(s) prior to installation or use.
- If you do not understand all of the instructions and cautions, or, if you have no mechanical experience and are not thoroughly familiar with the installation procedures, you must have the product installed by a professional installer.

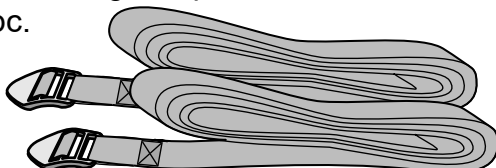

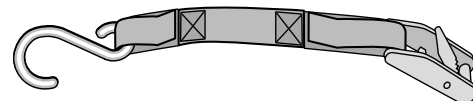
Medium Long Straps

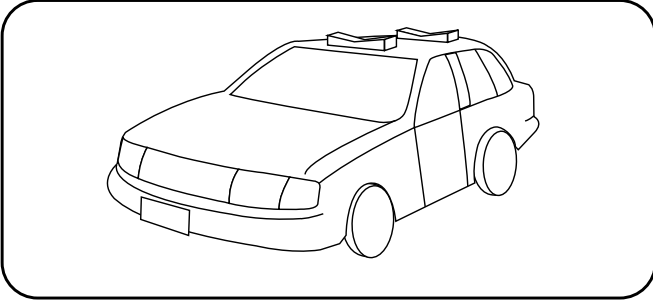

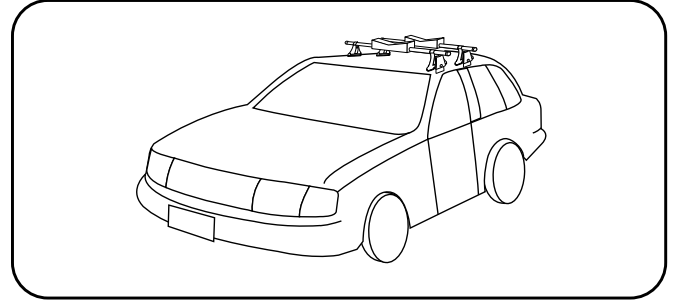
For Vehicles without Cross Rails:

- Put the blocks directly on the rooftop. Blocks must be at least 25 inches apart and as wide as allowed by the roof top for safety. Blocks must be put on a clean, free of debris and dry rooftop.



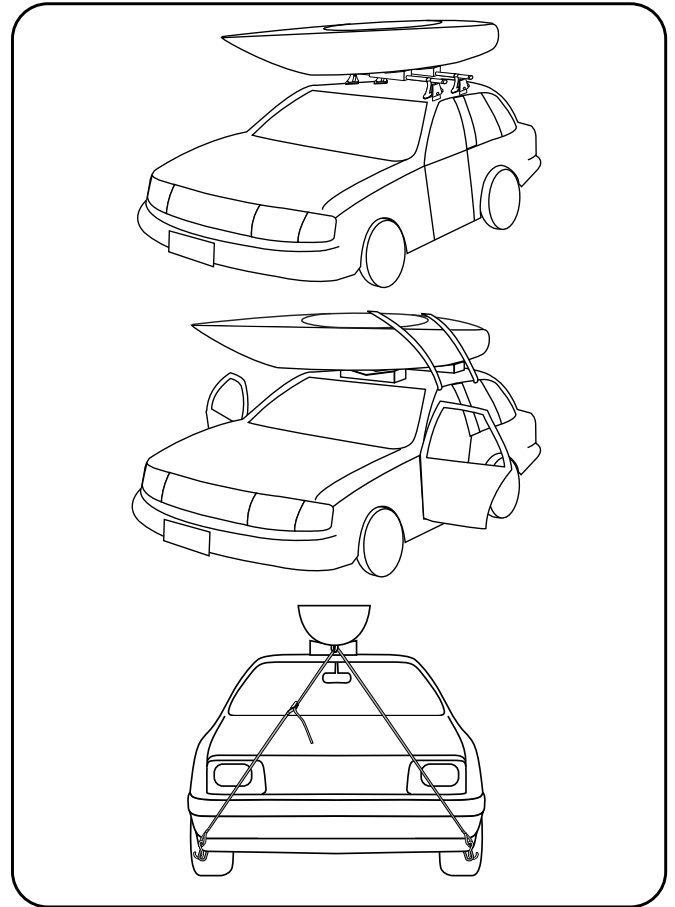
For Vehicles With Cross Rails:

- Put one block in the middle of each crossbar, align them and push until bar is inserted into dedicated slot. Crossbars must be properly installed, clean, free of debris and dry.



Loading and Securing the kayak:

- With the help of someone load the kayak on top of the blocks with the cockpit up. Make sure weight is evenly distributed on each block.
- Attach the kayak to the top. Open car doors on both sides. Pass the non-buckle end of the extra long strap over the kayak letting both ends hang on each side of the car. Bring both ends of the straps through the doors on each side and buckle the strap firmly inside the car.
- Repeat with the second strap. Make sure the straps are as far apart as possible not exceeding two thirds of the kayak length. Having the buckle inside the car allow you to verify and adjust tension when needed. Kayak cockpit must be covered on rainy days to avoid water accumulation in the cockpit.
- Using medium length strap and hooks, tightly secure kayak to front and rear of vehicle at secure fastening points. Kayak should stay snug to Carrier Kit when pushed fore and aft. If kayak slides, re-tighten all straps.



IMPORTANT WARNINGS

- About 3 miles after departure, stop and perform a full inspection of the straps, ropes, and blocks.
- Make sure the straps and ropes are not in contact with any sharp or abrasive surfaces.
- Check strap and ropes tension frequently.



Limited 1 Year Warranty

This Limited 1 Year Warranty covers Quest - brand Kayak Carrier Kits and has been specifically identified for inclusion in the program and is effective for as long as the original retail purchaser owns the product. This Limited 1 Year Warranty is limited to the original purchaser of the product and is nontransferable. Keep the original sales receipt – proof of purchase is required to make a warranty claim.

Subject to the limitations and exclusions described in this limited warranty, DICK'S Sporting Goods, Inc. or any of its affiliates (the "Company") will remedy defects in materials and/or workmanship by repairing or replacing, at its option, a defective product without charge for parts. The Company may elect, at its option, not to repair or replace a defective product but rather issue to the original retail purchaser a refund equal to the purchase price paid for the product, or credit to be used toward the purchase of a replacement Quest product.

Warranty Exclusions:

This warranty does not cover, and no warranty is given for defects or problems caused by normal wear and tear, which includes, but is not limited to, surface (aesthetic) metal corrosion, scratches, dents, deformities, accidents, unlawful vehicle operation, or any modification of a product not performed or authorized in writing by the Company. In addition, this warranty does not cover problems resulting from conditions beyond the Company's control including, but not limited to theft, misuse, overloading, or failure to assemble, mount or use the product in accordance with the written instructions or guidelines included with the product provided to the original retail purchaser.

Damage to original purchaser's vehicle, cargo, or property, and/ or to any other person or property is not covered by this warranty. In no event will the Company be liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, incidental, special, exemplary, or punitive damages or for any other damages of any kind or nature (including but not limited to lost profits, lost income or lost sales).

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations may not be applicable.

Implied Warranties Limited In Duration

EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT PROHIBITED BY APPLICABLE LAW, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ON THIS PRODUCT IS LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE DURATION OF THIS WARRANTY. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to you.



Disclaimer

Repair or replacement of a defective product, or the issue of a refund or credit (as determined by the Company) is the original retail purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy under this warranty. Except to the extent provided above or prohibits by law, the Company disclaims all other warranties, whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise.
