


KAYAK & SUP CART





IMPORTANT WARNINGS:

- Adult Use and Installation Only.
- This cart is intended for non-motorized transportation of a canoe or kayak from a car, trailer or storage area to the water.
- Do not carry passengers in boat during transport.
- Your Quest Kayak & SUP Cart will accept the majority of kayaks on the market.
- Any person(s) using Quest products are personally responsible for following the given directions for use and/or installation.
- Always check wheels, hardware and load straps for proper and secure attachment before transport.
- You must read and understand all of the instructions and cautions supplied with your Quest products(s) prior to installation or use.
- If you do not understand all of the instructions and cautions, or, if you have no mechanical experience and are not thoroughly familiar with the installation procedures, you must have the product installed by a professional installer.





- You must understand all of the installation instructions and follow the exact installation procedure for all Quest products.


ASSEMBLY

- Unpack, identify and layout all the components included in the carton. See image 1.
- Install wheel to axle. See image 2.
- Insert retainer pin through axle. Fold ring over the end of the axle to lock. Repeat Step 1 and 2 for second wheel. See image 3.
- Prepare the cart for the boat by opening the frame (A) and deploying the kick stand (B). See image 4.










USE

- Add the straps by passing the buckle through the open loop after going around the frame as pictured. Repeat on the other side of the frame and lay straps to the side. See image 5.
- Place the cart along side the kayak about two-thirds of the way back and lift the kayak onto the cart. As the weight of the boat is lowered, the cart will shift position and the kickstand will be elevated for easy access.
- Bring the two load straps over the kayak and pass the free end through the buckle. Pull the free end tight to secure the kayak to the cart. See image 6.
- Retract the kickstand and lift the front of the boat and pull forward to transport. See image 7.









Limited Lifetime Warranty

This Limited Lifetime Warranty covers Quest-brand Kayak/SUP Carts and has been specifically identified for inclusion in the program and is effective for as long as the original retail purchaser owns the product. This Limited Lifetime Warranty is limited to the original purchaser of the product and is nontransferable. Keep the original sales receipt – proof of purchase is required to make a warranty claim.

Subject to the limitations and exclusions described in this limited warranty, DICK'S Sporting Goods, Inc. or any of its affiliates (the "Company") will remedy defects in materials and/or workmanship by repairing or replacing, at its option, a defective product without charge for parts. The Company may elect, at its option, not to repair or replace a defective product but rather issue to the original retail purchaser a refund equal to the purchase price paid for the product, or credit to be used toward the purchase of a replacement Quest product.

Warranty Exclusions:

This warranty does not cover, and no warranty is given for defects or problems caused by normal wear and tear, which includes, but is not limited to, surface (aesthetic) metal corrosion, scratches, dents, deformities, accidents, unlawful vehicle operation, or any modification of a product not performed or authorized in writing by the Company. In addition, this warranty does not cover problems resulting from conditions beyond the Company's control including, but not limited to theft, misuse, overloading, or failure to assemble, mount or use the product in accordance with the written instructions or guidelines included with the product provided to the original retail purchaser.

Damage to original purchaser's vehicle, cargo, or property, and/ or to any other person or property is not covered by this warranty. In no event will the Company be liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, incidental, special, exemplary, or punitive damages or for any other damages of any kind or nature (including but not limited to lost profits, lost income or lost sales).

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations may not be applicable.

Implied Warranties Limited In Duration

EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT PROHIBITED BY APPLICABLE LAW, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ON THIS PRODUCT IS LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE DURATION OF THIS WARRANTY. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to you.



Disclaimer

Repair or replacement of a defective product, or the issue of a refund or credit (as determined by the Company) is the original retail purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy under this warranty. Except to the extent provided above or prohibits by law, the Company disclaims all other warranties, whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
