Why? Traditionally, you can still do more than you can on a tablet...

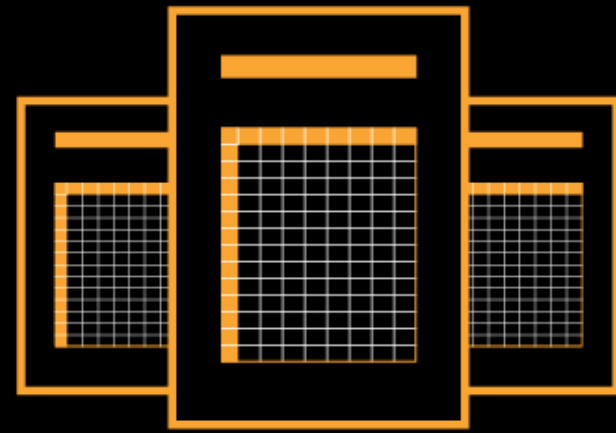
