HOW TO CLEAN LARGE EQUIPMENT WINDSHIELDS

Windshields on large machines are sometimes more than 4 meters (15 feet) off the ground. Use appropriate tools and equipment to clean windshields.

CLEANING LARGE EQUIPMENT WINDSHIELDS

- ☑ **USE PROPER TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT**
 - Use drive through wash stations when accessible
 - Make use of long-handled squeegees while standing on the ground or designated access system while maintaining adequate support
 - Use access system platforms and handrails that provide adequate support to perform the task
 - Make use of tie-off points and other fall protection
 - Do not stand on areas of the machine that are not intended to be used as an access system (e.g., fenders) to clean windshield
 - Do not stand on ladders to access the windshield
