Important Other Information

The initial training programme will require dayshift working for the first 4-6 weeks, within an Academy environment. All training takes place at the Caterpillar Desford Site.

Shift work will be required along with undertaking of the training programme and work placement training.

You may be required to bank hours occasionally to support production peaks and troughs.

On the job times will vary according to the business demand and subject to departmental variations.

From the 1st April 2018 the Apprentice National Minimum Wage is £3.70 per hour. This applies to 16-18 year old apprentices and those aged over 19 in the first year of their Apprenticeship. For all other apprentices the National Minimum Wage appropriate to their age applies. The Minimum Wage for Apprentices applies to time spent on the job plus time spent training.

Future Prospects
