A diamond mine in Russia had been buying DCF undercarriage for their D9 tractors. The Cat dealer presented the General Duty system with an undercarriage management program as a solution to lower the customer's cost per hour versus DCF. The customer conducted a trial on two of their D9 large track-type tractors, and the dealer monitored the undercarriage performance.

At 1,500 hours, the DCF undercarriage needed to have sprocket segments replaced and, at 3,000 hours, the DCF undercarriage system had to be fully replaced. The Cat General Duty had the link assembly and sprocket segments replaced at 3,000 hours. The rollers, idlers and track shoes could be reused and ran another 3,000 hours.
