
NEW FEATURES AND ENHANCEMENTS

Administrator

VisionLink now supports TrackUnit AEMP 2.0 and AEMP 1.2 API integrations.

When setting up TrackUnit integrations, select **TrackUnit** as the data provider, and then select an OEM name:

- OEMs Magni and BOMAG provide telematics data only in AEMP 2.0 format using the TrackUnit API to populate VisionLink mixed-fleet views. Select their names from the OEM Name drop-down list.
- For other OEMs providing data in AEMP 2.0 or AEMP 1.2 format using the TrackUnit API, select **Unspecified OEM** from the **OEM Name** drop-down list.




In VisionLink **Fleet Summary**, the **Source Name** column displays the OEM name when it is available. When the OEM name is unspecified, the column displays **TrackUnit**.



Unified Fleet

VisionLink Daily subscriptions now allow **Runtime** segments reported by assets to be processed and displayed in the **Asset Operations** page and **Asset Operation Duration (Hours)** displayed in reports generated in **Asset Operations**. Previously, **Runtime** segments were not processed and displayed in the **Asset Operations** page nor displayed in reports for assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions.



With this enhancement, **Engine/Ignition On** and **Engine/Ignition Off** events are bundled in a single message and sent to VisionLink once per day from assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions. A day is defined as midnight to midnight based on the time zone in which the asset is currently located. If the asset is powered down, out of coverage, or out of power, this message is sent when power is restored and the asset is in coverage.
