NEW FEATURES AND ENHANCEMENTS

Administrator reports

DEF % Remaining events are now available in Asset History and Asset Event Count reports.
 Previously, the DEF level remaining as a percentage was displayed only in the Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF) Level widget in the Asset Details Dashboard.

Note: VisionLink's ability to display DEF % remaining events depends upon each asset's device and subscription.

Now you can select multiple assets for Maintenance Multi-Asset Details and Maintenance History
reports. Previously, you could generate Maintenance Asset Details and Maintenance History
reports only for a single asset. To enable this enhancement, we merged and replaced existing reports
as follows:

These reports	are now these reports
Maintenance Asset Details + Service Due	Maintenance Multi-Asset Details
Maintenance History + Service History	Maintenance History

If you currently receive **Service Due** or **Service History** reports on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis, your reports are automatically converted to and renamed **Maintenance Multi-Asset Details** and **Maintenance History** reports, respectively. You will continue to receive these reports without disruption.

Note: From this point in time forward, you can add or edit only **Maintenance Multi-Asset Details** and **Maintenance History** reports. You can no longer generate **Service Due** or **Service History** reports.




KNOWN ISSUE

Cost Analysis reports are partially supported by assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions.

Assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions do not report **Idle Start** and **Idle Stop** events to VisionLink. This means **Idle** segments for assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions are not available in the **Asset Operation** page.

Cost Analysis reports use idle values from **Utilization** for **Idle Time (Hr), Idling Cost**, and **Idle %** columns. This enables idle values for assets, including assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions, to appear in these report columns:



However, Cost Analysis reports use Idle segments for # of excessive Idle Occurrences, Idling Time over Threshold, and Excessive Idle Costs columns. Since Idle segments are not available for assets with VisionLink Daily subscriptions, these last three columns always display 0 in Cost Analysis reports:
