- » \$500,000 investment in the College of New Caledonia in Prince George continues relationship that began in 2013
- » Provides equipment for heavy mechanical trades program — from toolbox sets and engines to transmissions, pumps and axles

BUILDING A WATER TREATMENT PLANT

- » \$21 million investment in Cusco, a mining area in the Colquepata district in Paucartambo, Peru
- » Quality drinking water and efficient sanitation for a community of 2,000 people
- » Three water reservoirs, plus distribution and collection networks

CREATING A NETWORK FOR MACHINE OPERATORS

- » Contributes to the development and recognition of heavy equipment operators
- » Provides access to knowledge and experience through free seminars
- » Currently has 13,000 members — the largest operator network in Peru



RELIANZ MINING SOLUTIONS

FOCUSING ON INCLUSION WITH WOMEN INITIATIVE NETWORK

- » Commitment to encouraging women that there is room for them in the mining industry
- » Students are invited to RELIANZ facilities and visits are made to secondary schools to encourage the study of technical careers without gender bias
- » More than 45 new women trainees currently participating in engine, welding and industrial process operations programs

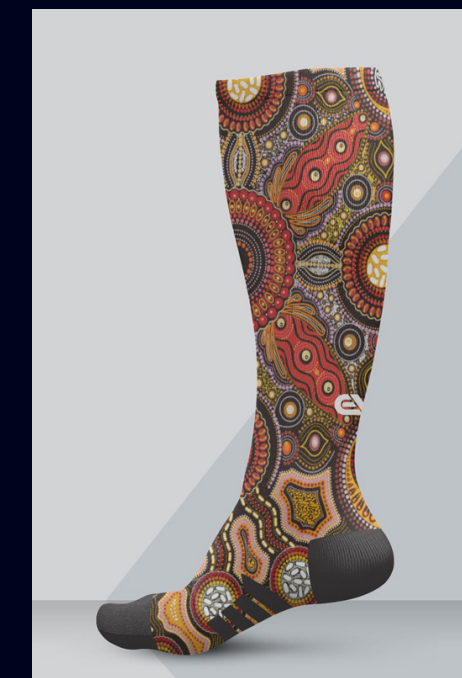
- » Partnership with Orange Sky Australia in support of homeless Australians
