




1. New SOS Inspection features


When submitting a SOS sample through Cat Inspect, users can now use the Fluid History feature to autofill the Fluid Brand, Fluid Weight and Fluid Type based on the Serial Number and Compartment combination entered. This feature is only available while your device is in a connected state. Fluid Type is now a new separate field that in previous versions was combined with Fluid Brand. In addition, the SOS sample workflow has been streamlined for adding additional compartments and submitting the sample.
















- 2. Dealer Website Assessment is now a new Site Category and Form Type. (See web release notes below)


NEW FEATURES & ENHANCEMENTS

Cat Inspect Web (February 15, 2022)

1. Organization Administrators can now deactivate users.


Admins are now able to deactivate a user from Cat Inspect by navigating to the "User Profile" page under the "Users" menu. Click the dropdown arrow next to account status and select "Deactivate". Once a user has been deactivated, they are no longer able to use the mobile app or website.





2. Changed the user archiving process.


Admins can choose to include or exclude a user from the Inspection Assignee list by clicking the box labeled "Display in Assignee List" under the "User Profile" page. This process was previously called "Archiving" and is now more explicit with an updated description. A user with an account type of "Active" can be listed as an assignee or removed as an assignee. Deactivated users will be removed from the Assignee list by default.



3. Dealer Website Assessment is now a new Site Category and Form Type.


The Retail Transformation team has created a new Dealer Website Assessment form in Cat Inspect that allows dealers to rate their customer facing webpages. To access this form, start a new Site inspection and select the Dealer Website Assessment Category and then click the Dealer Website Assessment form. This form can also be found under an Equipment inspection by first selecting the Product Family, Family-All and then clicking on the Dealer Website Assessment form.





4. Global Service Agreement has been added as a new form type.

This is a new form type added primarily for the CAT Marine's Delivery Service Center to create forms for the purpose of identifying contractually required inspections for Marine's Global Value Agreement customers. These forms will be created and released by engine arrangement in English with translations to Spanish, Portuguese, French, Simplified Chinese, and Russian to follow.
