Components from Pontiac go into several different models of Cat, Perkins and MaK engines, which serve owners of Cat machines worldwide. We supply stand-by power generation for data centers, hospitals, oil and gas rigs, rail and marine and industrial power systems. These components are also used to rebuild various engine models and give them a second/third life at our global remanufacturing facilities. The Caterpillar Pontiac Facility also provides machining, assembly, heat treat, cut, bend and weld products for Engine Fuel Systems and Aftertreatment. This consists of fuel injectors and many of the components in our injectors, fuel pumps and Aftertreatment products.

## **COMMUNITY IMPACT**

- Provide opportunities for every junior high student in Livingston County to participate in a STEM experience through the Challenger Learning Center at Heartland Community College.
