CSR PROGRAMS IN INDIA

Caterpillar's Commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility: Caterpillar believes in the power of responsibility. Through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs implemented by Caterpillar, subsidiaries and the foundation, it makes significant contributions to advance the health, welfare, and economic stability of the communities where we live and work. Numerous initiatives across three key areas — Environment, Education, and Employability — are being carried out to make communities more sustainable and resilient. From enhancing green cover, improving sanitation and increasing access to clean water to providing quality education and improved sanitation, these efforts reflect Caterpillar's commitment to building a better, more sustainable world.

Environmental Sustainability: As one of the core focus areas, Caterpillar India is dedicated to driving meaningful change across both rural and urban communities. Through the "Waterbody Conservation Program," Caterpillar India CSR is working to restore more than 800 acres of polluted lakes, benefiting over 1 lakh people across 35 villages. In urban areas, 'One Billion Drops' campaign aims to conserve rainwater by installing 1000 percolation wells. Similarly, to enhance green cover, around 40,000 saplings have been planted to develop Miyawaki forests in various government schools. In response to the significant decline in mangrove cover in Tamil Nadu and its adverse effects on coastal resilience, a community-led flagship initiative has been launched. As part of this project, over 92,000 mangrove saplings will be planted to restore ecological balance, enhance biodiversity, strengthen climate resilience, and support sustainable livelihoods.

Education and Infrastructure Support: Distribution of Teaching Learning Material (TLM) kits to more than 700 Anganwadis and upgradation of over 300 government schools. In addition, over 4,500 STEM libraries have been installed across government schools in Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Maharashtra strengthening science and technology education in underserved communities. Around 1,000 solar streetlights have been installed across Tamil Nadu to improve safety and access to basic needs, impacting more than 45,000 people. Mobile Science Labs distributed and have reached around 10,000 underprivileged children breaking barriers to science education and building a future fuelled by innovation.

Employability: Caterpillar aims to empower individuals from economically disadvantaged backgrounds with employable skills. The "Learn and Earn Program" at Caterpillar's manufacturing facilities offers technical training with a Diploma certification in Manufacturing Technology (DMT) to over 200 candidates. Through the 'Build the Bridge' project, we have provided comprehensive job readiness training to over 1,500 students from diverse economic backgrounds, including individuals with disabilities.

In times of natural disasters such as floods or cyclones, Caterpillar actively engages in disaster relief and recovery efforts, providing aid and support to the most vulnerable and affected communities.
