

A customer operating a truck fleet wasn't achieving desired production levels and planned to purchase more trucks. An FMC expert reviewed payload data and discovered the existing trucks were only being loaded to 60 percent capacity. The customer spent a little time training operators to load the current fleet fully—no additional trucks needed.

In a similar situation, another customer was using three trucks to move material. Telematics data analyzed by the FMC team indicated only two trucks were required for the work. The customer reassigned the third truck to another job with no loss in production.


