

#### **FAQs**

## Q: We use multiple software programs in our design department. How do we interface with those?

A: CET drawings and specifications can be exported and opened in various programs, including AutoCAD, Revit, CAP 20/20 and SketchUp.

# Q: We work with A&D firms who use programs such as AutoCAD and Revit. How can we share files and interact with those programs?

A: CET Designer has the ability to interact with most design programs. CET has import/export functions for CAD programs, and can import/export Revit files using the RevLink extension. CET can also import other file types such as jpegs and PDF.

### Q: In my dealership, designers are the ones doing discounting. Can I do that in CET?

A: Yes, discounting can be applied by CET using various parameters, including manufacturer, catalog or series code.

## Q: Do we still need to maintain programs like AutoCAD, 20/20 or Project Spec?

A: We recommend keeping standalone licenses for AutoCAD or CAD lite in order to reduce dwg file size prior to importing as a background in CET, but most dealers find that full CAP Studio license are no longer needed once full CET adoption is achieved. We know that every dealer has different processes around quoting, so some dealers elect to keep licenses for Project Spec or CAP Worksheet in order to create client proposals. CET Designer creates a SIF export to work directly with these ancillary quoting tools.

# Q: We design with other manufacturer's furniture. How do I plan and specify with those furniture lines?

A: The furniture manufacturer offerings in CET Designer has grown tremendously over the past several years. However, some small manufacturers do not have their own extensions. You can access all of symbols and catalogs you currently use in 20/20 in the Project Symbols extension in CET.
