- 4. Do not operate the device if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- 5. Unplug the power adapter from the power source, if you want to switch off the fogger for an extended period of time.
- 6. Use only original replacement parts.



- 1. Remove water container from tree stump decor piece. Twist off the lid and fill to the top with water. Secure lid and return water container to its original location.
- 2. Position fogger in the corner of your habitat and place cord through cord slots in the terrarium lid.
- 3. Plug fogger into an outlet near terrarium and press the control box to activate. Fogger is spraying when LED light flashes in the control box. Make sure to turn off fogger when desired humidity level has been reached.









Place water container Add water into the container. back inside décor piece.

Attention

- 1. Don't activate fogger spray without water.
- 2. Unplug when not in use. Drain remaining water and let dry.
- 3. Keep item away from children.
- 4. Keep button free and clear of anything that may cover it.
- 5. Always place fogger on a firm, flat, level surface. A waterproof mat or pad is recommended for use under the fogger.
- 6. DO NOT place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- 7. Never add any additive to the water.
- 8. Stop use if there is an unusual noise or smell.
- 9. If there is dripping water or dirt on the nozzle, it will take time to spray, otherwise you need to wipe out the water and dirt.

Warning

- 1. Working conditions: temperature between 41-104 °F (5-40°C).
- 2. DO NOT use distilled water, and water temperature can not be over 104 °F (40°C).
- Clean the bar inside the water container often.
