

DOG POOL INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Read and Follow All Safety Information and Instructions. Keep for Future Reference. Failure to follow these warnings and instructions can result in serious injury or death to users, especially children.

PREVENT DROWNING:

- Children under 5 are at highest risk for drowning.
- Closely watch children who are in or near this pool.
- Empty pool or prevent access when not in use.

Prevent Young Children From Drowning:

Install fencing or approved barrier around all sides of pool.

State or local laws or codes may require fencing or other approved barriers. Check state or local laws and codes before setting up pool.

Drowning occurs silently and quickly. Assign an adult to supervise pool and wear provided water watcher tag.

Keep children in your direct sight when they are in or near pool and when you are filling and emptying pool. When searching for a missing child, check pool first, even if you think your child is in the house.

Prevent Young Children From Gaining Access to Pool:

Position furniture away from pool so that children cannot climb and gain access to pool.

When leaving pool, remove floats and toys from pool that might attract a child.

Be Prepared to Respond to an Emergency:

Keep a working phone and list of emergency numbers near pool.

Become certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) so you can respond to an emergency.

Pool presents a drowning hazard even during filling and draining of the pool. Maintain constant supervision of children and do not remove any safety barriers until the pool is completely empty and stowed away.



WATER WATCHER:

Assign an adult to be responsible for watching children in the pool. Give this person a "water watcher" tag and ask that they wear it the entire time they are in charge of supervising children in the pool. If they need to leave for any reason, ask this person to pass the "water watcher" tag and the supervision responsibility to another adult.

IMPORTANT - READ BEFORE SETTING UP THE POOL

- Only set up on grassy, level area free of stones, sticks or dips.
- Set up in areas that comply with local safety and building codes.
- Allow a 6.5 foot clearance away from buildings, stairs, fences, walls, water, overhanging branches, washing lines, electrical wires and other hazards.
- Do not set up on concrete, asphalt or other hard surfaces.
- Do not install the pool on a slope or inclined surfaces, soft or loose soil conditions (such as sand or mud) or an elevated surface such as a deck, platform or balcony which could collapse under the weight of a filled pool.
- Do not lay in the sun for long periods of time as this may cause burns when touching.
- · Not for use indoors.
- Trim your dogs' nails before use, be careful to prevent dogs nails from catching on the pool base as sharp nails can cause a tear to mat base.
- Water level recommendation is 60% or less, do not overfill.
- Do not modify the pool.
- Do not set up or use if you suspect any damage to the pool.



INTENDED USE

- · Use as a pool for dogs only.
- · Use outdoors only

WARNINGS

- Not a toy.
- Not for use with children due to the risk of drowning. Keep away from children.
- Please do not let dog(s) in the pool before fill up with water.
- · Empty pool after every use.
- Never leave pool unattended in areas children can access.
- Do not leave your dog unattended while in the pool.
- Do not allow your dog to enter the pool if the water is cold to avoid a cold shock.
- · Always consult with your veterinarian before use, especially if your dog is sick or has an open wound.
- · Do not overfill the pool.
- Do not allow your dog to chew on the pool.
- Change the water as required to maintain hygiene.
- Do not tip to empty the water. Use the drainage outlet. You may tip to empty out residual water.

SETTING UP YOUR POOL

STEP 1 - Scope Out a Spot

Pick an area to set up your pool. It should be level, grassy and pretty roomy.



Now that you've picked a spot with plenty of room, unpack and unfold the pool, carefully spreading it out.



Once set up, and with the drainage outlet securely closed, fill the pool with water slowly. Don't leave unattended while filling.

PUTTING IT AWAY

STEP 1 - Drain the Water

Open the drainage outlet and let the water drain out.

Do not tip. Only tip the pool to drain residual water.

STEP 2 - Stop, Dry and Fold

Let the pool dry completely before folding up to store it.

STORING THE POOL

Once the pool is completely dry, you can store it away to keep things tidy.

- Store away from moisture and at room temperature.
- · Do not store near sharp objects.
- Always keep the drainage outlet closed during storage.

CLEANING THE POOL

Make sure to change the water frequently. Only allow your dog in the pool if the water is clean.

- Warmer weather may require more frequent water changes.
- The best cleaner is soapy water.
- Do not use bleach or harsh cleaning agents.

EASY TO FOLD & STORE

Let the pool dry completely before folding up to store it. Let the pool top face front when folding.
