

Adjustable Basket Muzzle



HELP WITH FIT Instruction Guide for Foam Pads & Head Strap Step 1 Usage Tip: Before using the foam pads, clean area of Figure a. with alcohol pads or wet wipes.



Option A: 0.25" high foam padding. Option B: 0.38" high foam padding.




1). Use adhesive comfort foam strips included inside to add extra padding for your dog's snout. Choose from two different sizes (See Option A and Option B above). Choose the most suitable size for your dog's needs.

2). Use adhesive backing to stick foam padding strips inside the muzzle. Each strip should fit in the areas indicated in Figure a.



1). Place the muzzle over the dog's nose. Be sure it is a comfortable fit. Your dog should be able to pant and drink while wearing the muzzle.




2). Bring the strap behind your dog's head and ears and fasten the buckle as shown in the above illustration.

3). Pull the end of the strap to adjust for a secure and comfortable fit. Do not over tighten. Strap should only need to be adjusted once.

Step 3

If your \mbox{dog} has a shorter nose, use the optional center head strap for a more secure fit.



Adjust the optional center head strap to help prevent your dog from removing the muzzle on their own.

1). Tighten the back loop so the strap stays in position and does not slide.

2). Tighten the front loop so the muzzle fits securely and comfortably.
