

IMPORTANT: Please read all instructions and warnings before using this product to ensure safe and proper use.

INSTRUCTIONS & EXERCISES

Placement of Blue "Snap-On™" Reed: The reed snaps on to the mouthpiece of the call with perfect tension. NOTE: When placed on the call, a dip or dimple should be on the center front edge of the reed (See Diagram). **Lip Placement:** This call requires very little air pressure, so don't blow too hard. Place your lower lip in the hole (See Diagram) and rest your upper lip on the rim or against the top of the call (See Diagram).



Lightly, blow air into the call so that air passes between the reed and your lower lip. You should immediately make a sound. Experiment with different lip and air pressures to control pitch and tone. Remember, no two elk sound exactly alike, but their pitch, rhythm, and sequence will be similar. For more detailed instructions, refer to the Mastering The

BULL SOUNDS - Place your lips on the end of the call as described above.

Growl - Blow air while making the sound "urrrr" for one to two seconds.

Bugle - Press your lower lip tighter against the reed and blow harder while pressing your lip harder each time you want to produce a higher note. It should last about three seconds.

Growl & Bugle - Blow the sound "urrr" into the call for one to two seconds, then quit saying the "urr" sound. Continue blowing call while slightly increasing the pressure of your lower lip against the reed to achieve higher notes. The bugle should last about three seconds: "urreeEEE."

Chuckle - Apply pressure to the reed using your tongue or your lower lip. Be sure air is sealed around the outside of the call with your mouth. Hold your tongue or lower lip tightly against the reed, build air pressure and pull your tongue or lip away rapidly, while saying the sound, "WHAA." Bull elk will chuckle just once or twice, or as many as ten times in a row.

Glunking - Usually made by herd bulls, you reproduce this call by taking the end of the Elk Hose and popping it five to ten times using the flat palm of your hand. If you can hear a bull making this sound, you are very close. Many times, this is the last sound needed to convince a bull that you are a bull who is trying to steal his cows.


COW & CALF SOUNDS - Place your lip on the end of the call as described above in Lip Placement section. Blow air into the call and imagine that you are trying to form the sound, "Eeeoooo." The "Eee" is the high note of the call and then the call tapers to a lower note, "ooo."

Mew - The mew is a bird-like sound that will vary in length from one to three seconds. It starts with a high pitch and ends in a lower pitch: "EEE-OOOOOO."

Chirp - This is a quick call, usually lasting about one second, starting with a high pitch and ending abruptly at a lower pitch: "EE-OO."

Calf Call - The calf call is generally higher pitched and shorter than the cow call: "E-O."

Estrus[™] Cow Sounds - This call is done the same as the calf call except you should go to a higher note before coming back to a lower note, while extending the sound: "EeeeeOOeeeOOO."
