

Acadia 2, 4 & 6-Pitching Instructions

Package Includes: Tent Body, Rain Fly, 2 long Wrapped Fiberglass Poles, 1 Ridge Pole (2 person fiberglass, 4&6 hybrid steel) Guy Cords, Tent Stakes.

Step 1: Find an even piece of ground, lay out tent body and stake corners. Assemble poles and lay long poles corner to corner crossing near the center of the tent. For 6 person tent, slide poles through pole sleeves.



Step 2: Insert pole tip into grommet on one corner of each pole. From opposite corner, flex pole and insert tip into grommet. Attach center clip to pole at center X.

Step 3: Work around the tent attaching all clips to the poles. Insert ridge pole ends into pockets on underside of fly above doors.



Step 4: Drape rain fly over tent body. Attach rain fly side release buckles at stake loop. Stake out tent vestibules and guy out as needed.
