

PRODUCT INFORMATION:

Read this information before proceeding. It is the user's responsibility to take the following precautions at all times.

- Always stake or weigh down your canopy. Do not use in any potentially windy or rainy weather. Wind and rain can damage your canopy and may also result in injury to you or others. Therefore, do not rely on canopy for protection in heavy or prolonged rain storms.
- This product is designed as a temporary sun canopy. Do not leave up for extended periods.
- Use caution when handling the canopy's frame. Avoid pinching hands or fingers as frame opens or closes.
- Do not use canopy in a lightning storm.
- Do not leave your canopy unattended.
- Do not build fires under canopy.

PRODUCT CARE & MAINTENANCE:

For long lasting durability and the best possible protection for your canopy, follow these care & maintenance instructions:

- Use a mild soap (not detergent) and plenty of water for top cleaning.
- Let the canopy top and frame dry completely before closing or storing to avoid mildew.
- The canopy frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess silicone residue before attaching top.
- Slightly tighten bolts if frame becomes loose.

2 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Z-Shade Co. Ltd., manufacturer of the product, warrants to the original purchaser who provides a dated sales receipt from an Authorized Dealer, each part of the Z-Shade product to be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of two (2) years after the date of original purchase. The frame is covered under a limited two (2) year warranty and guarantees the frame to be free from defects in material or workmanship. This warranty applies only for normal and expected uses, as determined by the manufacturer.

Z-Shade Co. Ltd. obligation and liability under this warranty is limited to the replacement of the product or its parts, after a review and examination of a submitted warranty claim.

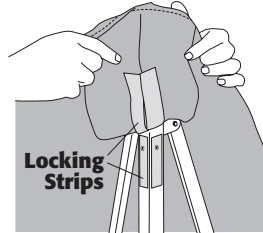
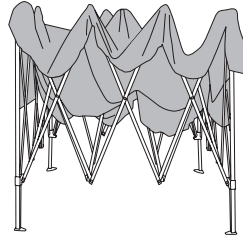
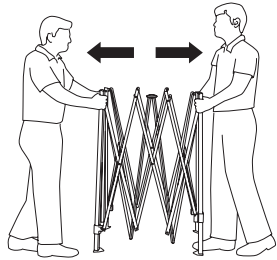

INITIAL SET UP

Please read each step before you attempt to set up. Save these instructions for future reference.



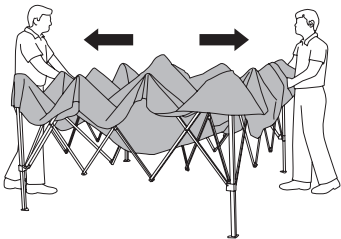
- 1** With partner, grasp two outer legs, slightly lift off the ground, and step backwards - stopping at full arms' length.

- 2** Unfold the polyester top and place it over the open frame.

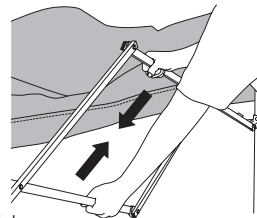
- 3** Secure the polyester top to the frame by attaching the locking strips on the top with the locking strips on the frame. *Fully, pull the corners down.*

SET UP

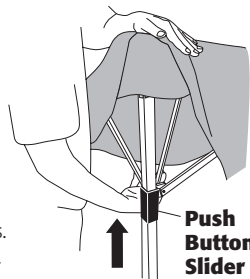
- 1** With partner on opposite side of canopy, place your Z-Shade frame in the center of area to be shaded. Grasp outer legs, lift off the ground, and step backwards - stopping at full arms' length.



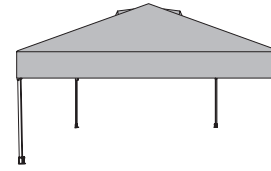
- 2** Grasp the top and bottom of the truss on opposite sides. Slightly lift canopy up and push hands together while stepping backwards until canopy is fully opened. Be careful not to pinch fingers or push too hard so as to avoid damage to truss.



- 3** To engage slider at each corner, first lift the fabric off of the slider. Then, with one hand hold the top of the leg while PUSHING UP the push button slider with other hand until slider engages. *Repeat on opposite legs.*

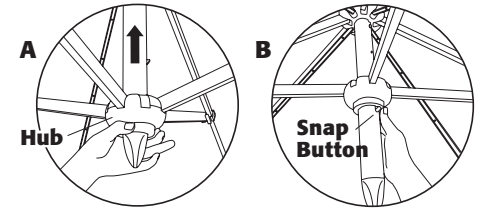


4 LOWERED CANOPY



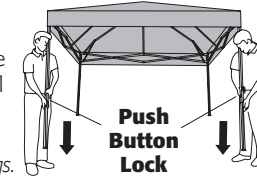
NOTE: With canopy in lowered position, **TAKE CAUTION** and walk UNDERSIDE canopy to raise.

UNDERSIDE CANOPY



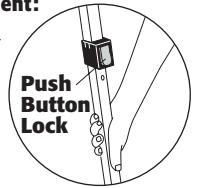
Push hub A) up the runner with one hand while holding upper frame with other hand until snap button B) locks.

- 5** Now, with partner, lift outer legs up and slide out the inner legs until the push button locks into outer legs. *Repeat on remaining legs.*



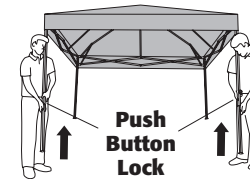
Height Adjustment:

Press push button lock to release and adjust legs to desired height. *Repeat on remaining legs.*



TAKE DOWN

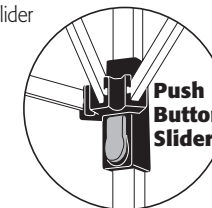
- 1** With partner, slightly lift up outer legs and press push button to unlock and telescope inner legs into outer legs. *Repeat on remaining legs.*



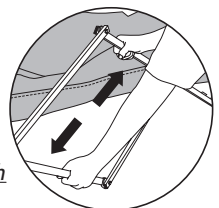
- 2** **LOWERED CANOPY** **NOTE:** With canopy in lowered position, **TAKE CAUTION** and walk UNDERSIDE canopy to begin to close.

UNDERSIDE CANOPY – Hold upper frame with one hand and with other hand push snap button to release hub carefully down the runner.

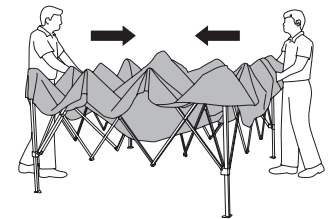
- 3** Press push button slider at each corner to release and unlock corners from truss. *Repeat on remaining corners.*



- 4** Grasp top and bottom area of trusses. Lift the canopy up slightly and shake while stepping towards your partner until 3/4 closed. *Be careful not to pinch fingers!*



- 5** With partner on opposite side, grasp top and bottom area of trusses. Lift the canopy up slightly and shake it while stepping towards your partner until the unit is 3/4 closed. With each partner grasping two outer legs, push frame together to fully close it. **Store canopy in roll away bag.**
