- The canopy frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess silicone residue before attaching top.
- · Slightly tighten bolts if frame becomes loose.







With partner, grasp (2) outer legs, slightly lift off the ground, and step backwards - stopping at full arms' length - approximately 3/4 its total size

Unfold the canopy top and place it over the open frame. – Align all corners of the canopy top over the corners of the frame

Secure the canopy top to the frame by attaching the canopy locking strips to the locking strips on the frame. Fully pull the corners down.


SET UP





With partner on opposite side, place your frame in the center of area to be shaded. Grasp (2) outer legs, lift off the ground, and step backwards - stopping at full arms' length.

Grasp the top and bottom of the truss on opposite sides. Slightly lift canopy up and push hands together while stepping backwards until canopy is fully opened. Be careful not to pinch fingers or push too hard so as to avoid damage to truss.




To engage slider at each corner, first lift the fabric off of the slider. Then, with one hand hold the top of the leg while PUSHING UP the push button slider with other hand the until slider engages. Repeat on center legs.



Height Adjustment:

Press <u>push button</u> lock to release and adjust legs to desired height.

Repeat on remaining leas.




With partner, lift outer legs up & slide out the INNER legs until the push button locks into outer legs. Repeat on opposite leas.

- Next, with partner, push button to release and adjust center legs.

Tie Downs (6): (Available on 16'x 8' only.) Attach guy ropes to stake in the ground (roughly at 45°) to support the canopy. Repeat on remaining tie downs.

TAKE DOWN



NOTE: Release Tie Downs prior to Take Down. With partner, raise & slightly lift up CENTER legs, push button to unlock and telescope inner legs into outer legs.


- Next, lift up outer legs and <u>push button</u> to unlock and telescope inner legs into outer legs. Repeat on opposite legs.




Release push button slider at each corner by first lifting fabric away from slider. Push button slider to release slider and unlock from truss.

Repeat on center legs. Note: It is much easier to

release push button slider when the canopy weight has been removed from the push button sliders.



Grasp the top and bottom of the truss on opposite sides. Slightly lift canopy up and pull hands apart while stepping towards your partner until canopy is 3/4 opened.



With partner on opposite side, grasp (2) outer legs, push frame (slightly and shake canopy) together while stepping towards your partner until fully closed. Be careful not to pinch fingers!

Store canopy in dust cover or roll away bag.
