Maintenance

Installing the Dumbbell Bases (Item #5) to the Stand

Attach the Dumbbell Bases after all other parts (Items #1-4) have been assembled. The rubber stabilizers must be removed from the Dumbbell Bases before assembly. Use a #2 Phillips screwdriver (not included).



Remove the dumbbell from its base before you attach the dumbbell base to the stand to make sure that the dumbbell does not fall during installation.

Fully tighten the hardware before you put the dumbbells into the installed dumbbell bases on the stand.
