Assembly Instructions

Step 1:

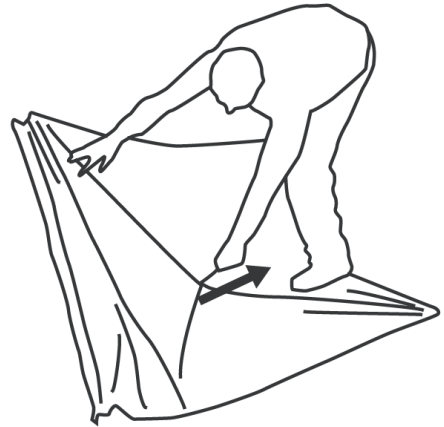
Unfold blind with hubs facing down and unzip the bottom door zipper.



Step 2:

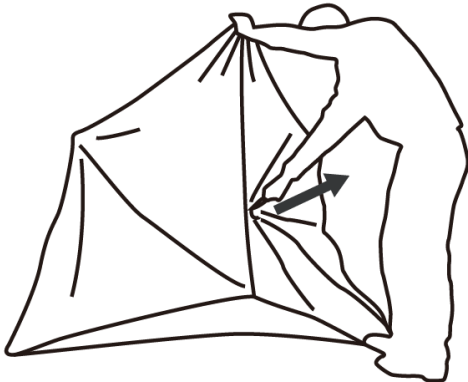
Pull outward to pop up the roof panel first.

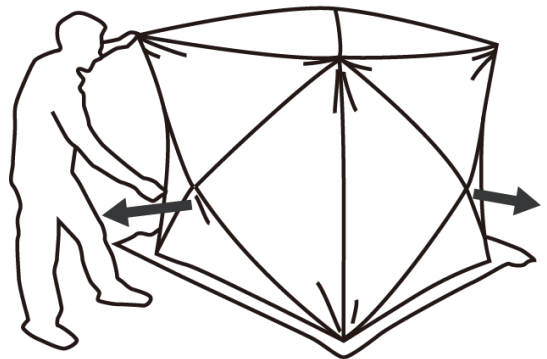
Step 3:

Lift the blind and pull outward to pop out side wall.



Step 4:

Move around blind to open remaining side walls.

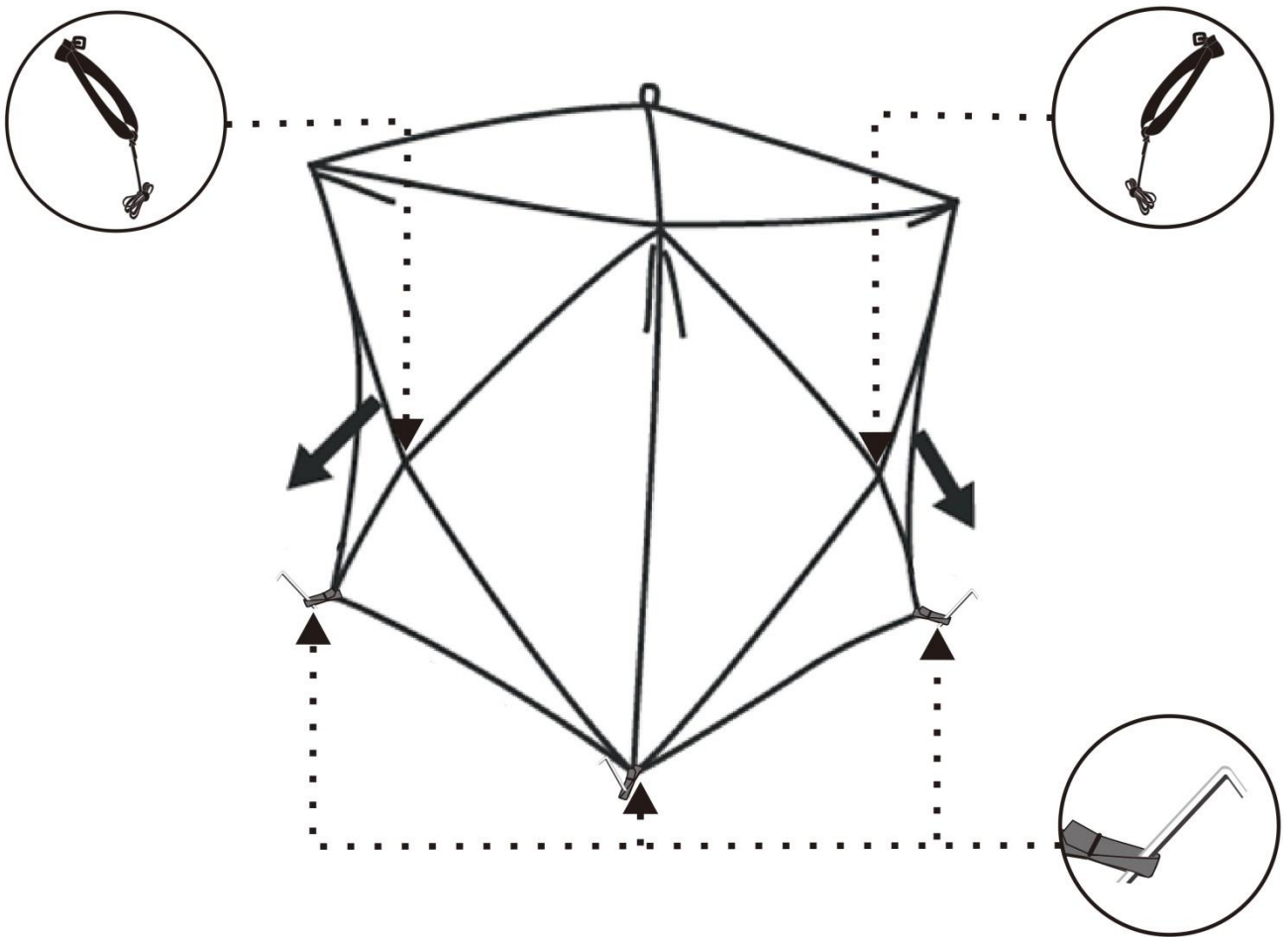

Step 5:

Optional: Secure blind with included ground stakes and guy ropes.

Adjust Windows.



IMPORTANT: Be sure to remove ALL brush, dirt, debris, ground stakes and close ALL windows **BEFORE** beginning take-down.

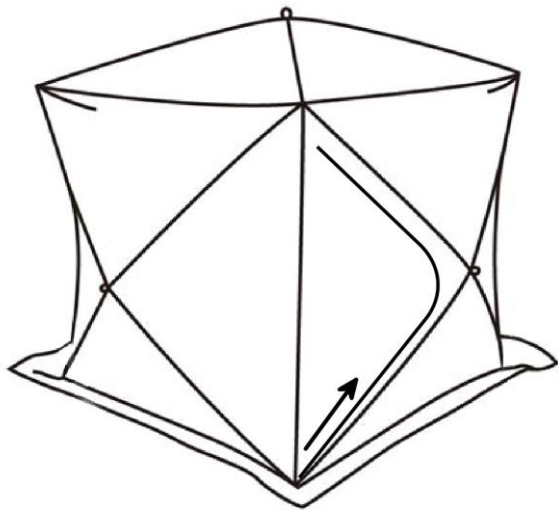

Disassembly Instructions

Step 1:

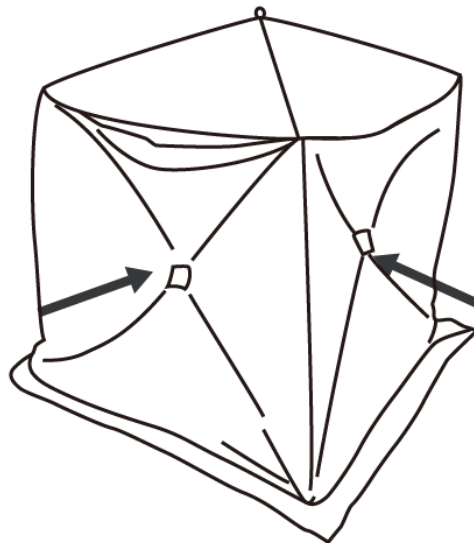
Close all the windows and unzip the bottom door zipper before disassembly.

Remove ground stakes.



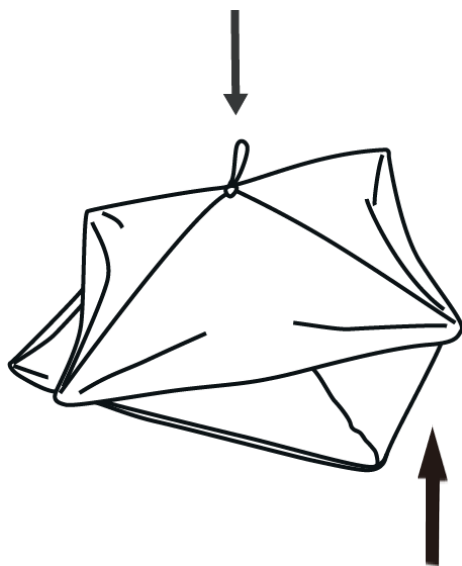
Step 2:

Push in center hub of one side wall until the tension begins to give. Repeat on remaining side walls. Once all side walls have been pushed in the blind will collapse onto ground.



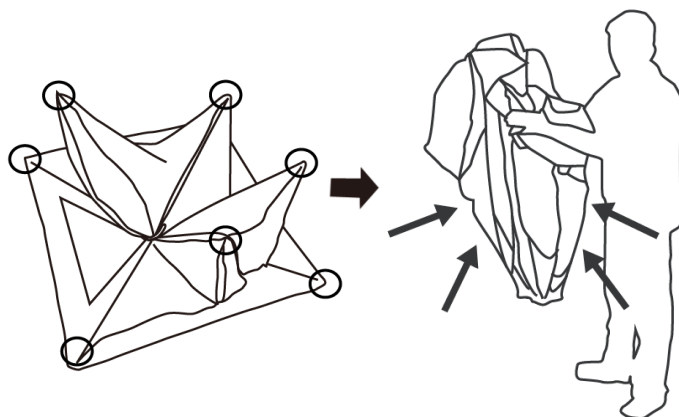
Step 3:

Push in center hub pole of roof and lift bottom corner of blind until tension gives.



Step 4:

Gather all corners of blind and then place blind into carry bag with HUBS AT THE BOTTOM & THE SOFT ENDS AT THE TOP.



Care and Maintenance

- Your product must be stored dry. Storing your product while damp or wet could cause damage to the fabric. Storing a wet blind as briefly as 24 hours in warm weather is likely to cause mildew on the fabric coatings and is not covered by the limited warranty.
- If you must close the blind in the rain, open your product and set it up to allow it to dry as soon as possible. Allow dirt to dry on the fabric after a rainfall before lightly sweeping it off with a brush. For tougher stains, spray the area with water and lightly wipe it off with a few strokes. Do not use washer or dryer. **DO NOT SCRUB THE FABRIC. ALWAYS MAKE SURE THE BLIND IS COMPLETELY DRY BEFORE REPACKING.**
- Do not leave your blind set up for weeks at a time. Exposure to ultraviolet rays from the sun can damage and/or discolor the material.
- Clean the poles with a cloth and lubricate them with a silicone spray to help prevent corrosion and keep from being gritty.
- Store the stakes in the separate storage bag. Do not pack the stakes inside the blind.

Limited 6 Months Warranty

- If your product does not work properly because of a defect in materials or workmanship, Westfield Outdoor Inc will, for 6 months from the date of purchase, at its option either (a) repair our product with new or refurbished parts, or (b) replace it with a new product. The decision to repair or replace will be made by Westfield Outdoor Inc.
- WESTFIELD OUTDOOR INC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE SUBSTITUTIONS TO WARRANTY CLAIMS IF PARTS ARE UNAVAILABLE OR OBSOLETE.
- If repair is needed during the limited warranty period, the purchaser will be required to furnish a sales receipt as proof of purchase indicating date of purchase; amount paid, and place of purchase. Product will not be covered under warranty due to damages resulting from misuse, excessive or abusive usage, and/or inclement weather conditions (i.e. wind storms, hurricanes, lightning storms, tornadoes). Acts of nature resulting in damage to blind and its components are not covered under this limited warranty. In such event, the consumer assumes cost of needed parts. Westfield Outdoor Inc is not responsible for normal wear and tear, zipper exhaustion, or the natural breakdown in materials that occurs with extended use.
