MARINE RAIDER ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS & USER'S MANUAL

EASY LIFT TRAILER JACK 163890



AWARNING: Do Not Exceed 4000lb Rated Load Capacity. Failure to Follow Instructions and Heed Warnings May Result in Personal Injury and/or Property Damage

AWARNING: This jack is for use on trailers only. Only use jack on hard flat surface. Never attempt to lift more than one wheel. Do not raise inflated tires over 2" (5cm) above the ground. Correct operation requires a minimum of two people. Avoid being under any part of the trailer when the jack is in use.

ACAUTION: The operation of this jack requires two people that have read and fully understand these instructions.

▲CAUTION: • Keep free of debris and grease Clean with soap and water



Step 1. Position the trailer onto a hard packed or solid surface that is as level as possible. Place the EZ Lift Trailer Jack under the trailer axle closest to the wheel that you want to lift. Make sure to locate an area that the jack's movement will not be obstructed by any trailer components such as U-bolts or brackets as it moves forward. Position the axle notch onto the trailer axle with the flat side of the EZ Lift Trailer Jack facing the tow vehicle. Wedge the jack securely between the axle and the ground. (See fia 1.)



Step 2. With a second person observing the operation of the jack from a safe distance away from both the trailer and tow vehicle slowly pull the tow vehicle forward until the flat side of the EZ Lift Trailer Jack is in a vertical position. The observer will instruct you when the jack is in the correct position. (See fig 2.)





Step 3. Once the EZ Lift Trailer Jack is in the proper vertical position turn off the tow vehicle. Apply the emergency brake and chock the remaining trailer wheel/s both forward and to the rear of the wheel/s for safety. Perform the necessary maintenance to the trailer being careful not to have your hands, legs or other body parts under the frame or running gear of the trailer at any time (See fig 3.)

Step 4. Once you have completed the necessary maintenance on your trailer inspect the surrounding area to make sure that it's free of any tools or other obstacles that could interfere with the performance of the jack. Then with the observer positioned at a safe distance from the trailer and tow vehicle remove the chocks from the trailer wheel/s. Disengage the tow vehicle's emergency brake and slowly back up until the observer indicates that the tire is lowered back onto the ground and the jack is free from the axle. Remove the jack from under the trailer and store. (See fig 4.)
