



#### Step1:


#### Alert !!

Be sure the corners of Body B (#4) are overlapping the corners of the triangular frame on the Top Round (#1) and Bottom Bowl (#2). Refer to the right diagram.

Stabilize the Bottom bowl (#2) on the ground with the 2 small brackets facing front. Attach Body B (#4) to Top Round (#1) and Bottom Bowl (#2) with bolts (D, M8 x 15) and flat washers (J, 8mm) at the CENTER HOLES. At the same time, attach the Lock/Lock Latch (#18 & #19) assembly to the Top Round (#1) at the center hole (note no need to use washer on this hole) .DO NOT tighten bolts in this stage.

In the same manner, attach the Lower Leg (#10) to the Middle Leg (#9) using bolts (A, M8x70), flat washers (J, 8mm) and locking nuts (H, M8). TIGHTEN all bolts. Reserve the bottom hole on middle Leg (#9) for Step 10.



Insert an Upper Leg (#8) through the slot on the Stand Platform (#11) and then attach it to the Body bar (#6). Tighten with bolts (A, M8x70) and locking nuts (H, M8) at the lower hole meanwhile attach Stabilizers (#21) per diagram. At the same time, attach Front Handle (#17) to the Body Bar (#6) using bolt (A, M8x70) and nut (H, M8). Note: Four flat washers (J, 8mm) are required at the top and bottom brackets of the Front Handle.





### **HOW TO LOAD YOUR FEEDER**

OPEN THE LID AND POUR FEED INTO THE HOPPER. ONE BAG AT A TIME. DO NOT USE A LEAN-TO OR EXTENSION STYLE LADDER TO AID IN FILLING THE HOPPER. THIS COULD CAUSE THE FEEDER TO TIP OVER AND CAUSE INJURY. IF ADDITIONAL HEIGHT IS NEEDER FOR FILLING, USE A SIMPLE A-FAME STEP PLATRORM LADDER. AFTER FILLING, CLOSE AND LOCK THE LID.

#### **TIPS & POINTERS:**

- (Q) What kind of feed should I use?
- (A) Whole kernel corn is recommended. Whole kernel corn mixed with soybeans or pellets is also effective for attracting deer. NOTE: When not mixed with corn, some types of pellets can take on moisture and clog the feeder.



### **HOW TO INSTALL BATTERY**




REMOVE TIMER KIT COVER AND INSTALL A 6v RECHARGEABLE BATTERY (NOT INCLUDED) BY ATTACHING RED ALLIGATOR CLIP TO THE POSITIVE TERMINAL (+) AND BLACK ALLIGATOR CLIP TO THE NEGATIVE (-) TERMINAL.

### **HOW TO OPERATE THE TIMER**

READ THE OPERATION MANUAL INCLUDED IN THE TIMER KIT UNIT.

THE PROPER SPACING BETWEEN THE SPIN PLATE AND THE FUNNEL IS 3/8 INCH (0.953 cm). THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR SERVICE- FREE OPERATION.



### **Care and Maintenance**

- INSPECT FEEDER FOR ANY LOOSE PARTS OR HARWARE REGULARLY
- CHECK IF FEEDER IS TAKING WATER ON RAINY DAYS. SEAL GAP WITH SILICONE SEALANT IF NECESSARY
- IF RUST APPEARS ON THE EXTERIOR SURFACE OF FEEDER, CLEAN AND BUFF THE AFFECTED AREA WITH STEEL WOOL OR FINE GRIT EMERY CLOTH. TOUCH-UP WITH A GOOD QUALITY PAINT
- STORE FEEDER INDOORS WHEN NOT IN USE
- CLEAN FEEDER HOPPER REGULARLY TO AVOID CLOGGING AND DAMAGE TO THE CONTROL UNIT



#### Step 1:

Install the Game Winner Solar Panel Assembly to the Body C using bolts (SP3, M6x15).

**Note:** It is recommended to install Solar Panel before loading or when it is empty.

Install the Universal Solar Panel Fixture (#27) on the right side of the Body C using bolts (SP3, M6x15).





#### Step 2:

With a knife, make an incision to the rubber bushing just larger enough to insert the conduit into the mounting bushing on the Body C (shown at A). Then continue passing the conduit through the mounting bushing at the bottom of the Bottom Bowl (shown at B). Finally, insert the conduit into the mounting bushing on the Timer Kit (shown at C).





### Assembly completed

#### Remark:

- 1. Optional placement of the solar panel would be in a Southerly direction.
- 2. Always check the solar panel terminals to insure there is no unnecessary build-up of any corrosive matter which may be detrimental to your battery.
