

Have a personal plan and practice it in the presence of a responsible adult before leaving the ground. No one escape/rescue plan will work for every hunter, on every tree, in every circumstance. Only you can determine the best self-recovery/escape plan for your hunting situation and you must have a self-recovery/escape plan for your individual situation before leaving the ground. There is time to make a correct decision on what action to take if a fall occurs while wearing a full-body fall arrest harness. It is important to remember, "DO NOT PANIC." You must only hunt from the ground when self-recovery/escape ability is absent. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

Several optional products/systems are available that offer self-recovery or self extraction from a fall when suspended in a harness. Some systems automatically descend the user while others allow user control. One of these products/systems can be considered for use as an additional safety precaution against prolonged suspension and suspension trauma. Be sure to follow the manufacturers' directions on the safe use of these products/systems.

WARNING! A suspension relief device must be on your person and readily accessible while using your full-body fall arrest harness. These devices allow the user to relieve the load on the lower extremities if suspended in a harness and help maintain circulation in the legs, mitigate suspension trauma (blood pooling) or allow descent to the ground. 

These devices add necessary balance and support for the complete climbing system. Failure to properly use and attach those items, and to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! When installing this ladder treestand you must bounce on the first rung to set the ladder into the ground prior to attempting to climb any higher. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! You must check every ladder section connection every time you use the stand before you leave the ground. The sections should be connected securely using the provided u-brackets and bolts which add support and ensure proper connection. If you find that the ladder sections are separating, or if any of the u-brackets or bolts are not properly attached, DO NOT USE the treestand. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

WARNING! You must check the ground under the treestand to make sure it is firm and level. Sloping ground or uneven surfaces (e.g., one foot on a rock) can cause your ladder to tilt or shift off the tree as you climb. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

WARNING! You must maintain three (3) points-of-contact when climbing the ladder (i.e., two feet-one hand, two hands-one foot). Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! You must always lean forward as you climb and attach your full-body fall arrest harness to the tree before securing the platform to the tree and stepping onto the standing platform. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Always have a second adult present or at least accessible by cell phone or other means when using this product. The ability to get help quickly may save your life in the event of a fall. 
# **Product Diagram**

Step 1:


Locate Tree Brace (#1), Left Bending Bar (#2) and Right Bending Bar (#3). Install Tree Brace (#1) onto the Left Bending Bar (#2) and Right Bending Bar (#3) using four (4) M8x60 Bolts, eight (8) Steel Washers and four (4) Locknuts as shown in Figure 1. Securely tighten bolts.



Install Tree Brace/Left Bending Bar/Right Bending Bar

#### Step 2:

Locate two Ladder Connect Bars (#6). Install the Ladder Connect Bar (#6) onto Left Bending Bar (#2) and Right Bending Bar(#3) using two (2) M6x35 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 2. Securely tighten bolts.



#### Step 3:

Locate Standing Platform (#8). Install the front of Standing Platform (#8) onto the Ladder Connect Bars (#6) using two (2) M8x70 Bolts, four (4) Nylon Washers, two(2) thicker Nylon Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 3. Securely tighten bolts.

**Note:** Please place one thicker Nylon Washer between the Standing Platform and the Ladder Connect Bar.




#### Step 4:

Locate Seat Support Frame W/Tree V Brace (#11). Install the Seat Support Frame W/Tree V Brace (#11) onto the Standing Platform (#8) and Tree Brace(#1) using four (4) M8x55 Bolts, eight (8) Steel Washers and four (4) Locknuts as shown in Figure 4. Securely tighten bolts.



#### Step 5:

Locate Foot Rest (#7). Install the Foot Rest (#7) onto the two Ladder Connect Bars (#6) using two (2) M8x70 Bolts, four (4) Nylon Washers, two(2) Thicker Nylon Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 5. Securely tighten bolts.

Note: Place one thicker Nylon Washer between the Foot Rest and the Ladder Connect Bar.

WARNING: Never step or stand on Foot Rest!




Install Foot Rest

#### Step 6:

Locate #4 Ladder Section (#13) and two U-Brackets (#19). Slip the crimped end of #4 Ladder Section (#13) into the Ladder Connect Bars (#6) and secure with two U-Brackets (#19) using four (4) M6x40 Bolts, eight (8) Steel Washers and four (4) Locknuts as shown in Figure 7. Securely tighten bolts.

WARNING: U-Brackets are required and must be used to provide support for the attachment points between the ladder sections. Bolts must be threaded through them on both sides of the ladder section. Locate two Ladder Braces (#9).


Install one end of Ladder Braces (#9) onto the #4 Ladder Section (#13) using two (2) M8x60 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 7.

#### Step 8:

Install another end of Ladder Braces (#9) onto Standing Platform (#8) using two (2) M8x55 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 8. Securely tighten bolts on both ends of Ladder Braces.



#### Step 9:

Locate Seat & Backrest Frame (#10).




Figure 9 Install Seat & Backrest Frame

Install the Seat & Backrest Frame (#10) onto Left Bending Bar (#2) and Right Bending Bar(#3) using two (2) M8x65 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers, two (2) thicker Nylon Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 9. Securely tighten bolts noting seat is designed to rotate up and down.

Note: Please place the Nylon Washer between the Seat & Backrest Frame and the Bending Bar.

#### Step 10:

Install the Seat & Backrest Frame (#10) onto Bending Bar Tab using two (2) M8x45 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 10. Securely tighten bolts.



#### Step 13:





Figure 13 Install Shooting Rail Support Bars

Locate two Shooting Rail Support Bars (#4). Install the Shooting Rail Support Bars (#4) onto Left Bending Bar (#2) and Right Bending Bar(#3) using two (2) M8x115 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers, two (2) Thick Nylon Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 13. Securely tighten bolts noting shooting rail is designed to rotate up and down.

Note: Please place one Thick Nylon Washer between the Shooting Rail Support Bar and the Platform Connect Bar.





Figure 15 Install Armrest





Figure 17 Install Hand Wheel for Shooting Rail Support

Locate two M8x65 Hand Wheels, bolting them on the Left Armrest (#20) and Right Armrest(#21) as shown in Figure 17. These two M8x65 Hand Wheels are used for Shooting Rail support. Securely tighten Hand Wheels.

Note: Shooting Rail height can be adjusted by bolting Hand Wheels on 3 different holes on the Arm Rest Bars. Always make sure both Hand Wheels are at same level so Shooting Rail contacts both Hand Wheels evenly.

#### Step 18:

Locate #3 Ladder Sections ( #14). Slip the male end of the #3 Ladder Section (#14) into the female end of the #4 Ladder Section (#13) first; Then secure 3 Ladder Sections with two U-Brackets (#19) using four (4) M6x40 Bolts, eight (8) Steel Washers and four (4) Locknuts as shown in Figure 18.

Repeat this step for remaining two ladder section from #2 to #1.

WARNING: U-Brackets are required and must be used to provide support for the attachment points between the ladder sections. Bolts must be threaded through them on both sides of the ladder section. DO NOT omit U-Brackets. Failure to properly use the U-Brackets could lead to serious injury or death.



#### Step 19:




Figure 19 Install Adjustable Tree Brace Mount

Locate Adjustable Tree Brace Mount (#18). Install the Adjustable Tree Brace Mount (#18) onto the #2 Ladder Section (#15) using two (2) M6x60 Bolts, six (6) Nylon Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 19. Securely tighten bolts.

Note: Please place one Nylon Washers between the Adjustable Tree Brace Mount and the #2 Ladder Section each side.

#### Step 20:

Locate Adjustable Tree Brace (#17). Slip the Adjustable Tree Brace (#17) into the Adjustable Tree Brace Mount (#18) and secure them using one (1) M6x45 Bolts, two (2) Nylon Washers and one (1) Wing Nut as shown in Figure 20. Securely tighten bolt.

WARNING: Adjustable Tree Brace, Tree Brace and Bolt with Wing Nut must be installed. DO NOT omit these components. Failure to properly use these parts could lead to serious injury or death.



#### Step 21:




Figure 21 Install Plastic Shelf

Locate Plastic Shelf (#22). Install the Plastic Shelf(#22) onto the Bending Bar(Either Right or Left Side) using two (2) M8x45 Bolts, four (4) Steel Washers and two (2) Locknuts as shown in Figure 21. Securely tighten bolts.

#### SELECTING A SAFE TREE:



TREESTAND MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM TREE SIZE: 9 – 24" DIAMETER!

Never use treestand on a dead, leaning, diseased, loose barked tree, tree with excessive vines or on utility pole or any other man-made structure.

Never use on trees that contain nails, screws, or other sharp objects that may cut, sever, or puncture strap webbing or cables!

Never rely on a tree branch for support!

Failure to follow these instructions can lead to serious injury or death!

- Select a healthy straight tree that fits within size limits larger than 9-inches in diameter and smaller than 24-inches in diameter at attachment height.
- Always thoroughly inspect tree from all sides before installing product.
- Be sure treestand platform is level. Tree must not lean or have any irregular shapes.
- Do not select a tree with vines or limbs below your desired hunting height.
- Never attach treestand to limbs! Always attach treestand to main trunk of tree.
- Never use treestand on trees with wet, icy, slippery, loose or scaly bark.

#### PRACTICE AND BECOME FAMILIAR WITH PRODUCT AT GROUND LEVEL:

Always practice attaching/detaching, adjusting and using treestand and full body harness at ground level prior to using at elevated positions.

Prior to using treestand and full body harness at elevated positions for first use of each season, test operation and use at ground level.

#### FULL BODY SAFETY HARNESS (FALL ARREST SYSTEM – FAS):

You must wear and use supplied 4 point full body harness when installing and using this treestand.



Always connect harness to tree as soon as possible and prior to stepping on the platform and always remain harness to tree until you leave platform.

Read and understand included Full Body Harness Instructions, Warnings, and watch safety video for instructions on using your full body harness.

Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury or death.

Refer to Full Body Harness (FAS) Instruction Manual supplied with this treestand for proper wear, adjustment, usage and maintenance.

### SETTING UP THE GAME WINNER LADDER STAND ONTO THE TREE

WARNING! STOP! Make sure that you are wearing you full-body fall arrest harness. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Prior to attempting to use this, or any other Game Winner product(s), you must take a moment and become familiar with its setup and installation at ground-level. You must practice installing, setting-up using and removing product(s) and full-body safety harness at ground-level prior to attempting to use it at heights above ground-level. Once you have become thoroughly knowledgeable and comfortable with this Game Winner product(s) setup, installation use and removal at ground-level, you're now ready to use it at heights above ground-level. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

#### STEP 1:

Select a straight healthy tree that is larger than 9-inches in diameter and smaller than 24-inches in diameter at attachment height.

#### STEP 2:




Figure 22 Install Stabilizer Straps

Attach the two (2) Stabilizer Straps (#23) to both the left and right sides of the standing platform as shown in Figure 22. Attach by looping strap loop around back corner of standing platform tube and insert end of strap through strap loop. Pull tight so strap is secure on platform tube and positioned next to tree brace. Repeat for strap on other side of standing platform tube.

WARNING! Make sure stabilizing straps do not contact tree teeth.

#### STEP 3:

Allow Straps to hang freely from the standing platform.




WARNING! You must check the ground under the treestand to make sure it is firm and level. Sloping ground or uneven surfaces (e.g., one foot on a rock) can cause your ladder to tilt or shift off the tree as you climb. Prior to attempting to climb a ladder stand for the first time, make certain the feet of the bottom rung ladder section are firmly planted on solid, level ground. If they are not firmly planted on level ground, DO NOT climb the ladder. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! Your Game Winner Ladder is designed, engineered and constructed in a manner that makes it a rugged piece of hunting equipment that will give you years of trouble-free service. This rugged-construction makes your Game Winner Ladder physically heavy. As such, you should never attempt to install this ladder by yourself. YOU MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) ADULTS FOR THE SAFE ERECTION OF YOUR treestand. In addition to helping carry the heavier construction of the stand, the use of three people are required for set up. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

**STEP 4:** You are now ready to lean your ladder stand up against the tree. Please note that it takes a minimum of three (3) adults to perform this operation. With the ladder stand laying flat on the ground in front of the tree, place the legs approximately 3' to 4' from the base of the tree.

**STEP 5: Tip Ladder Up to Tree.** Have one adult hold bottom of ladder while guiding/pulling stand with stabilizer straps while the other two adults raise ladder stand to tree shown in Figure 23. Have two adults lift platform and walk ladder stand up tree so ladder stand is in vertical position and teeth on Seat Support Frame are contacting tree. Once positioned against tree, step back from the tree and determine if the ladder stand's seating platform is level. If it is not level, move the legs of the lower ladder section closer or further from the tree (as appropriate) until the seating platform is leveled. Once level, always have one person step/bounce on bottom ladder rung to set ladder into ground.




WARNING! Always make sure platform is level! If platform is leaning forward, leaning back, leaning left or leaning right reposition treestand or select different tree.

#### STEP 6:


Once the ladder stand platform has been leveled, adjust tree brace assemblies by lengthening or shortening so they fit snugly against the tree trunk and provide rigid support to the ladder sections. Adjust the braces length so they are snug against the tree trunk. Secure brace with (1) M6x45mm bolt, (2) washers and wing nut shown in Figure 20. Once the adjustable tree brace is snug and the standing and seating platform are level, install the Adjustable Tree Brace Strap (#25) onto the adjustable tree brace to secure it to the tree trunk. To accomplish this, attach hook through hole on tree V and wrap strap around back of tree and attach other hook through hole on other side of tree V and pull strap tight. Adjustable tree brace and strap must be tight and secured to tree trunk shown in Figure 24.

#### Note: Strap and adjustable tree brace must be very tight and secured to tree!




Figure 25 Stabilizer Straps Installed

**STEP 7:** Now take the stabilizer straps and crisscross them behind the tree trunk so straps cross just below platform and pull them snug and tie them to a rung on the middle ladder section (or the highest rung you can safely reach from the ground) as shown in Figure 25.

WARNING! Prior to climbing, make sure that all the ladder sections are securely connected with U-Brackets, tree braces are secure to tree (with bolt and strap), stabilizer straps are installed and the ladder assembly is solidly secured to the tree. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!




Figure 26 Connect Yellow Tension Strap

**STEP 8:** Wrap yellow tension strap (#26) around both stabilizer straps and pull tight drawing stabilizer straps together. Wrap tension strap around drawn stabilizer straps 3 to 4 times and tie off tension strap so it will not loosen (see Figure 26).



WARNING! Prior to attempting to climb a ladder stand for the first time, make certain the feet of the bottom rung ladder section are firmly planted on solid, level ground. If they are not, firmly planted on level ground, DO NOT climb the ladder. With three (3) adults, lower the stand and find a suitable location to safety install the ladder stand. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



WARNING! When climbing to secure the ratchet strap, always have two (2) adults hold base of ladder steady against tree. Always lean forward when climbing to keep the stand centered and secure to the tree trunk. DO NOT lean backwards when climbing! 



**STEP 9b:** After your tether has been attached to the tree trunk securing your position, attach the ratchet straps (#24) to secure the top of the stand to the tree. First, install upper ratchet strap (#24) by attaching hook onto loop (hook facing away from tree) on Tree Brace (#1) and wrap the strap around tree trunk and attach to loop (hook facing away from tree) on opposite side of Tree Brace as shown in Figure 28. Using ratchet, tighten strap so it is very tight. Install second lower ratchet strap (#24) by attaching hook through hole (hook faces down) on Seat Support Frame w/ Tree V Brace (#11) and wrap strap around tree trunk and attach hook to hole on opposite side of Tree V Brace as shown in Figure 28. Using ratchet, tighten strap so it is very tight.

NOTE: For ratchet threading instructions, refer to Figure 29. NEVER ATTEMPT TO THREAD A RATCHET ABOVE GROUND LEVEL.
