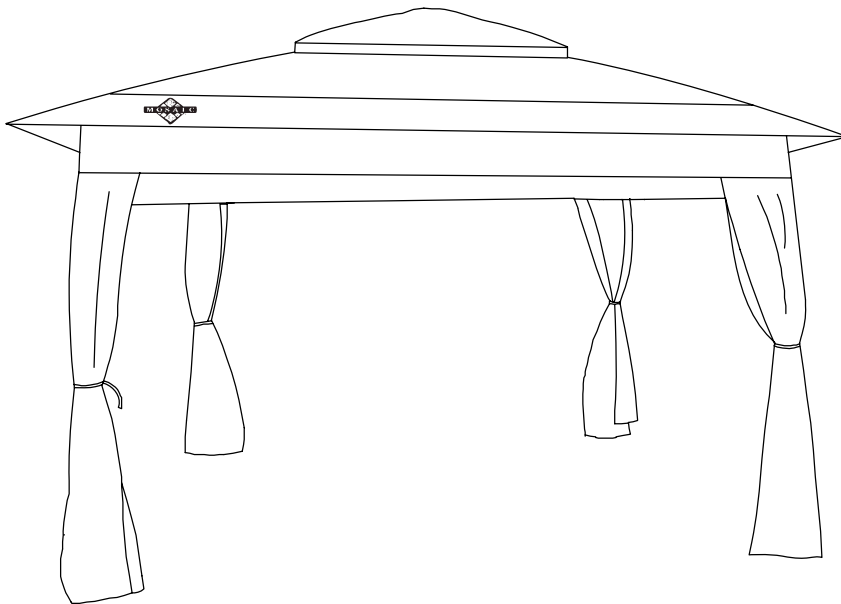

CAUTION: Never set up or continue to use in any rain, wind, or storm conditions, especially lightning storms. Damage can occur to the tent and put you and others in potential danger.





CAUTION: Be careful not to pinch your fingers in the frame during set up and take down.

CAUTION: Do NOT use this tent for permanent shelter. It is designed for temporary use only.




CAUTION: Avoid setting up the tent on steep inclines.

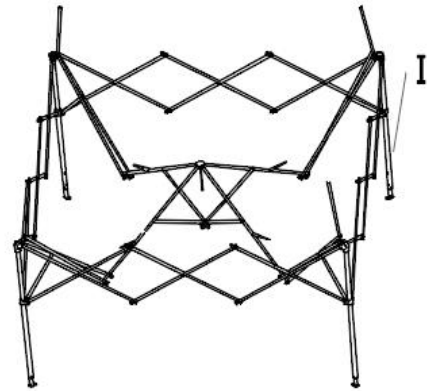
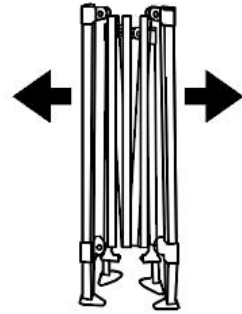

Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Opening the canopy frame

With one person lift and partially pull the canopy frame (I) apart.

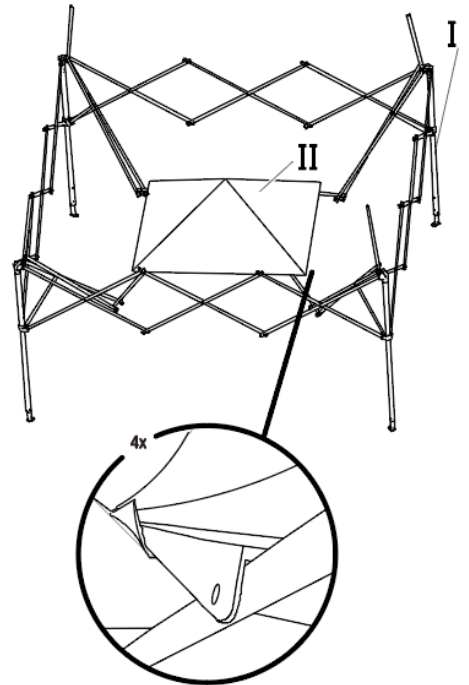
Note: At this step do not press the center up yet.



Step 2: Attaching the small canopy top

Unfold the small top (II) and place it over the open frame (I).

Attach the four canopy corners to the frame top.

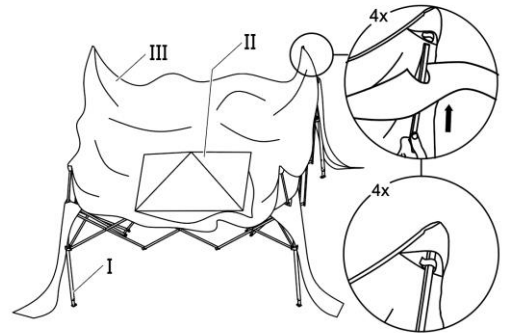

Step 3: Attaching the large canopy top

Unfold the large top (III) and place it over the open frame (I). Be sure the neckband of the large top (III) is totally under the small top (II)

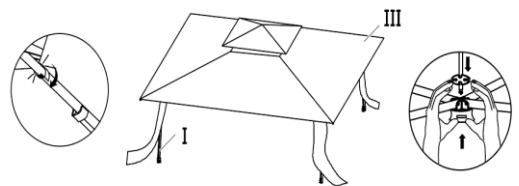
Attach the four canopy corners to the awning pole.



Step 4: Locking the frame

Under the canopy, place one hand on the upper frame and use the other hand to push the central hub straight up until it clicks into the central pole and touches with the bottom tray part.

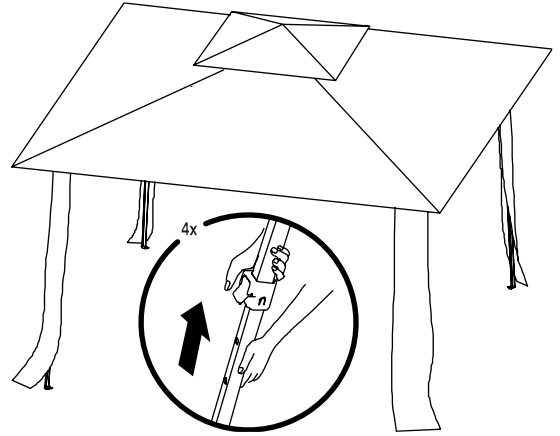
Finish attaching the large canopy (III) inside the canopy frame (I) using the hook and loop closures.

Step 5: Adjusting the canopy height

Press the dark brown/blue button on each leg to raise or lower to adjust the canopy height.

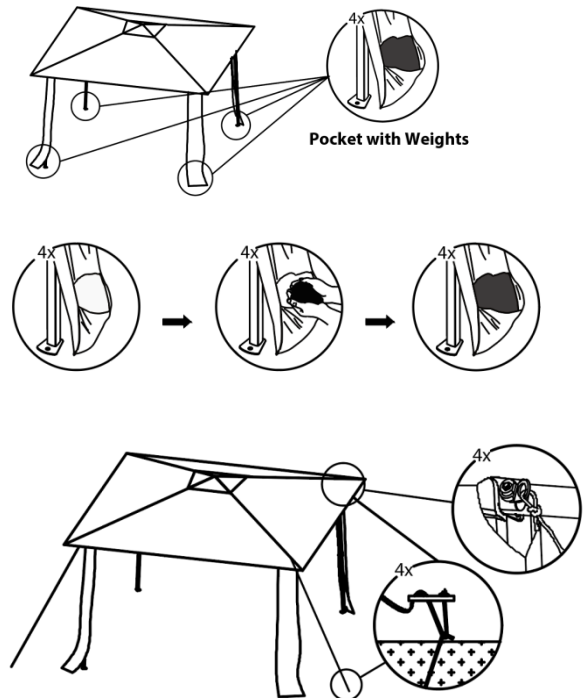


Step 6: Securing the canopy

Please fill in the pockets with bottle water or rocks / sand / bricks as weights.

Tips: Weights must be applied to prevent damage from wind.

Secure the ropes through the metal rings and have the proper tension by adjusting the plastic adjusters on the ropes

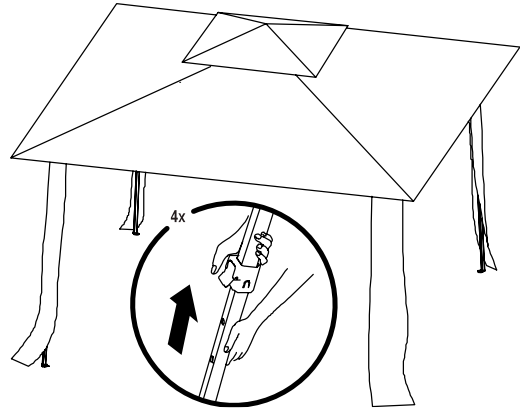


Take down Instructions

Step 1: Removing the stakes and retract the legs

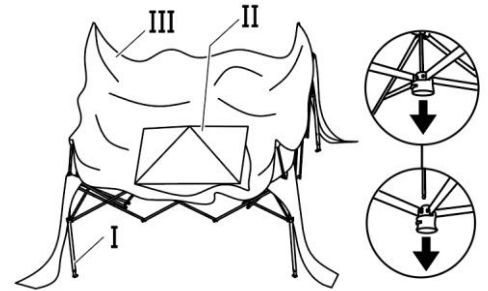
Remove stakes & ropes.

Press the dark brown/blue buttons on all 4 legs to collapse the canopy legs.



Step 2: Unlock the central lock

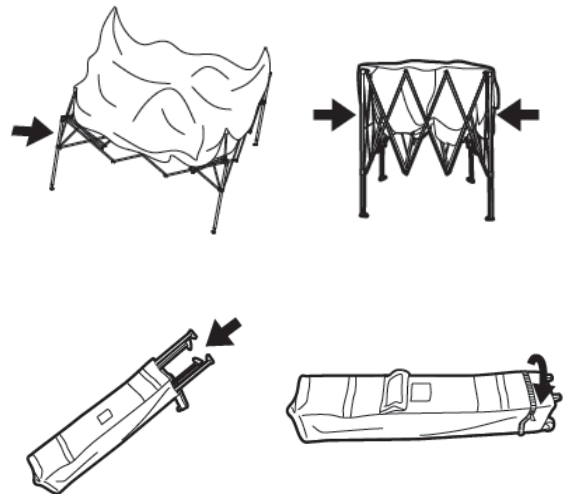
Release the center by pressing the dark brown/blue button on the center hub and pulling down toward the ground.



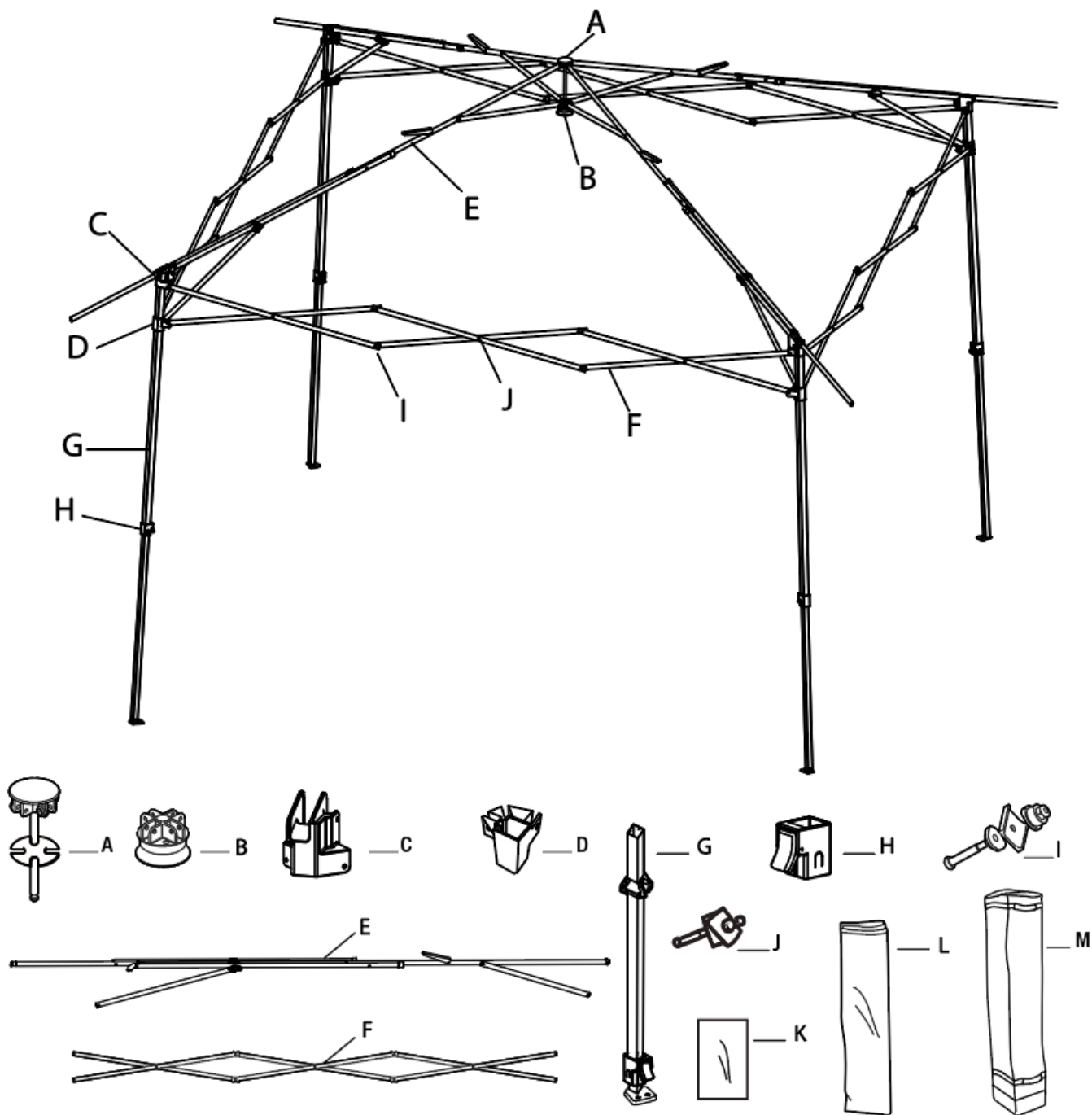
Step 3: Fold down the frame & packing the canopy in the roller bag

Go to the outside of the canopy and push canopy legs together toward the center.

Place canopy back in the roller bag with canopy top still on. Place stakes and ropes in pouch on the exterior of the bag.
