# Assembly Instructions

## Step 1:


Attach Feed Spouts (#4) to base of Bottom Hopper (#2B) using bolts (B, M8x15), washers (C, 8 mm).

**Tighten bolts with tool**

Hardware :

#B - 12 pcs

#C - 12 pcs



## Step2:

Attach Upper Legs (#5) to previous hopper assembly using bolts (B, M8x15), washers (C, 8 mm) and lock nuts (D, M8).


**Hand Tighten bolts and nuts in this step**

Hardware :

#B - 16 pcs

#C - 32 pcs

#D - 16 pcs


## Step 3:

Simultaneously attach Lower Legs (#6) and Support Bars (#7) to previous hopper assembly using bolts (A, M8x20), washers (C, 8mm) and lock nuts (D, M8).

**Hand Tighten bolts and nuts in this step**

Hardware :

- #A - 8 pcs
- #C - 16 pcs
- #D - 8 pcs




## Step 4:

Connect Leg Skid Blades (#8,9) using bolts (B, M8x15), washers (C, 8mm) and lock nuts (D, M8).

**Tighten bolts and nuts with tool**

Hardware :

- #B - 4 pcs
- #C - 8 pcs
- #D - 4 pcs



# Assembly Instructions

## Step 5:

Attach Leg Skid Blade assemblies in previous step to Lower Legs using bolts (B, M8x15), washers (C, 8 mm) and lock nuts (D, M8).  
\*Lower Legs sit on Leg Skid Blades


**Tighten all bolts and nuts in this step and in steps 2,3 with tool**

Hardware :

#B - 4 pcs

#C - 8 pcs

#D - 4 pcs



## Step 6:


Attach Lock Latches (#3) to Top Hopper (#2A) using bolts (E, M4) and lock nuts (F, M4).

**Tighten bolts and nuts with tool**

Hardware :

#E - 4 pcs

#F - 4 pcs

## Step 7:


Attach Top Hopper (#2A) to Bottom Hopper (#2B) using bolts (B, M8x15) and washers (C, 8mm).

**Tighten bolts and nuts with tool**

Hardware :

#B - 16 pcs

#C - 16 pcs




## Step 8:

Put Lid (#1) onto hopper and lock with Latch Lock (#3). Then, add Stakes (#10).

**Make sure all bolts and nuts are tightened with tool in all steps.**

Assembly is now finished.




# HOW TO LOAD YOUR FEEDER

OPEN THE LID AND POUR FEED INTO THE HOPPER. AFTER FILLING, CLOSE THE LID.

## TIPS & POINTERS:

**(Q) What kind of feed should I use?**

**(A) Whole kernel corn is recommended. Whole kernel corn mixed with soybeans or pellets is also effective for attracting deer. NOTE: When not mixed with corn, some types of pellets can take on moisture and clog the feeder.**



# Care and Maintenance

- **INSPECT FEEDER FOR ANY LOOSE PARTS OR HARWARE REGULARLY**
  - **CHECK IF FEEDER IS TAKING WATER ON RAINY DAYS. SEAL GAP WITH SILICONE SEALANT IF NECESSARY**
  - **IF RUST APPEARS ON THE EXTERIOR SURFACE OF FEEDER, CLEAN AND BUFF THE AFFECTED AREA WITH STEEL WOOL OR FINE GRIT SAND PAPER / EMERY CLOTH. TOUCH-UP WITH A GOOD QUALITY PAINT**
  - **STORE FEEDER INDOORS WHEN NOT IN USE**
  - **CLEAN FEEDER HOPPER REGULARLY TO AVOID CLOGGING**

1. Manufacturer warrants this product to be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase, PROVIDED claims are submitted, in writing, with proof of purchase.
2. 4. This Limited Warranty is given to and covers the **ORIGINAL PURCHASER ONLY** and such coverage terminates 90 days from the date of purchase.
