The Asda Shopping List activity with Makaton is designed to help guide people who go shopping at Asda but may need a little extra support in their communication when making their shopping choices; also it is a great way of encouraging children to get involved with helping with the shopping.

Makaton is a language programme that gives everyone a helping hand to talk. Makaton is proven to develop speech, language and communication skills. Using gestures and pictures, people can tell someone what they want, make choices and join in.
