
About Jean-Michel Cousteau President, Ocean Futures Society

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NATURALIST FOR A DAY

Is your group going whale watching in the Santa Barbara Channel, kayaking at a local state park, hiking the Gaviota Coast (SoCal's longest stretch of undeveloped coastline) or snorkeling The Channel Islands? If so, our Naturalists join your expedition - supplying local insight to the flora, fauna and history of the area, providing guests with binoculars, presentations and models to better explain our pristine ecosystems along the way.

Excursion Price: \$100/hour/guide.

PRIVATE ECOHIKE

Explore our coastal nature trail and discover interesting adaptations that enable plants and animals to survive in this arid landscape. Step back into time as we understand how the Chumash survived on this land for thousands of years. On the hike, we engage in a scavenger hunt, several interactive discussions, and challenge activities. Time: Approximately 1 - 1.5 Hours

THE AMAZING RACE

Using a sense of humor teams take part in fun and engaging challenges that promote team collaboration. Teams are handed score cards and a team captain elected. Teams have 1 hour to complete as many of the challenges they find set up on the beach. Using strategy and cooperation, teams must come up with solutions and complete the 3D life size challenges. After 1 hour scorecards handed in and the winning team announced.

ELLWOOD ECOHIKE

The thousands of Monarch Butterflies that migrate to Ellwood each year are a testament to this bluffs serene beauty. Featuring miles of trails, a hard-sand beach and breathtaking vistas. Time: 1.5 hours including roundtrip transportation (5 minutes each way) Excursion Price: \$50/person.
