Deep Dives into Nikko's Nature, Culture, and Spirituality.

Taking full advantage of our location within Nikko National Park, a destination revered for its scenic beauty as well as the splendid architecture of its UNESCO-designated Shinto shrines and Buddhist temples, The Ritz-Carlton, Nikko is pleased to offer more than two dozen guest activities that showcase the unique offerings of this highland setting. Walk through protected wetlands, stroll the precincts of centuries-old sanctuaries, meditate under waterfalls or try ice climbing in winter. Master the Japanese skill of *furoshiki* wrapping, sit zazen or witness a mystical fire ceremony . . . all of these experiences and more await.





All-Year Activities

Morning Zazen Meditation

Duration

30 minutes



Start your day by connecting with the breath in this morning zazen practice—a meditative discipline of sitting to calm the mind, let go of distractions, and look inward to foster insight. Leading the session is a monk from the nearby Chuzenji Temple.

90 minutes

Morning Temple Walk



Greet the day with a lakeside walk to Chuzenji Temple, whose history stretches back to 784. The round-trip route is just three kilometers (1.9 miles), and can include entry into some of the halls to see an acclaimed dragon painting, statues of the five wisdom kings, and the principal object of worship—an eleven-faced, thousand-armed statue of the bodhisattva Kannon said to have been carved by the temple's founder.



Fire Ceremony

Duration

2 hours



At Chuzenji Temple, a sanctuary dating back to 784 and affiliated with the World Heritage Rinnoji Temple, engage in a writing meditation by copying an image of the Kannon bodhisattva or a wellness sutra related to the deity of compassion. Then, witness the burning of holy cedar sticks in a dynamic fire ceremony. The rhythmic chanting of monks and snap-crackling flames will transport you to an otherworldly place of tradition and mysticism.

45 minutes

Hotel Art Tour

Hear the unique stories behind a dozen or so of the artworks on display in different places throughout the hotel. Our guest experience team will conduct this tour.

Furoshiki Art





Learn creative ways of wrapping using the *furoshiki*. This simple square-shaped cloth makes for a colorful and environmentally friendly way to hand-carry just about any item, or present one attractively as a gift.

Kagura Shrine Dance

Duration

1 hour

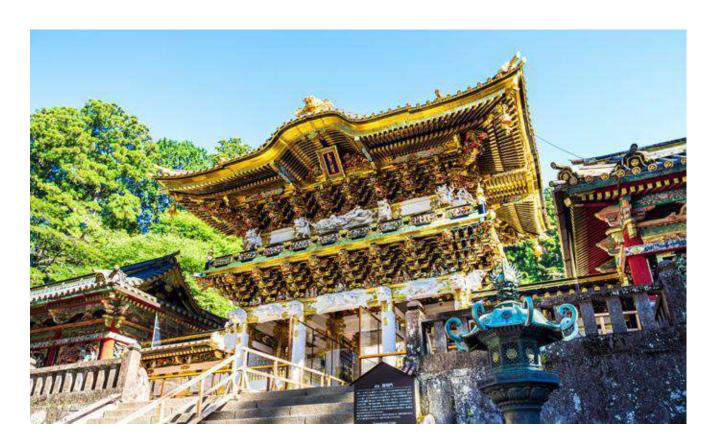


Enjoy a guided tour and view a ceremonial *kagura* dance performed by a shrine maiden at Chugushi Shrine, a sanctuary affiliated with Nikko Futarasan. Accompanied by *taiko* drumming and a traditional bamboo wind instrument, this ritual offering to the Shinto gods expresses appreciation for bountiful crops and overall wellness.

UNESCO World Heritage Site Tour

Duration

4 hours



Stroll the precincts of UNESCO World Heritage sites Rinnoji Temple and the Toshogu and Futarasan Shrines. At Toshogu, enjoy a guided tour of the complex led by a Shinto priest and shrine maiden, and experience a purification ritual in an ornately decorated chamber once reserved for use by the Tokugawa shoguns. Included in this excursion are visits to the three sacred cedar trees of Takio Shrine, an auxiliary shrine of Futarasan; and Kanmangafuchi, a riverside footpath lined with 70 stone statues of Jizo, the patron saint of travelers and children.

Nikko Carving Experience

Duration

2 hours



Try your hand at the Nikko-bori style of woodcarving in a class led by the mother-daughter duo who created the wall carvings in our Japanese restaurant. You'll use the *hikkaki* chisel, a line-carving tool with a deep dogleg that's unique to the Nikko tradition. Learn from the masters as you embellish a wooden plate or hand mirror with a design of your choice.



Duration

1 hour

OkuNikko Stargazing



OkuNikko is one of the best places to view the starry night sky in the entire Kanto region, whether with the naked eye or a powerful telescope that lets you observe the Milky Way and craters on the moon. Here in the highlands no light pollution interferes with the unforgettable canvas that unfolds after dusk.

Prayer Beads Workshop

Duration

90 minutes



Select your preference of beads made of natural stone, wood, or seeds and thread them to fashion your own personal set of prayer beads just right for the size of your hands.

When your work is finished, a monk will bless it to make it complete.





Spring Summer Autumn Activities



Paddleboarding

Duration

2 hours



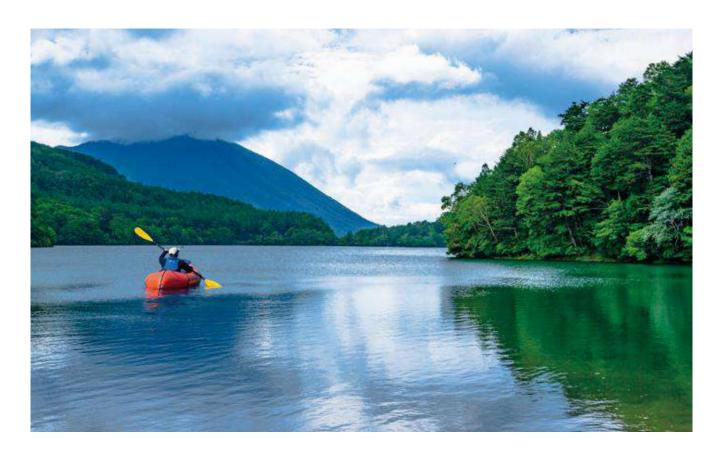
Enjoy spectacular views of the nature all around you right in front of the hotel as you glide across Lake Chuzenji on a stand-up paddleboard. Five-meter (16-foot) mega boards for couples, friends, and families with little ones are available as well as SUPs for solo rides.



Packrafting on Lake Chuzenji

Duration

3 hours



Slip a light inflatable packraft into your backpack and set out on a scenic forested walk following the shoreline of Lake Chuzenji. Then, inflate and board the vessel for your very own private lake cruise, with the vast beauty of OkuNikko stretching above, below, and all around you.

Sundown Lake Ride

Duration

90 minutes





At an altitude of 1,270 meters (4,160 feet), there's no lake in Japan closer to the heavens than Lake Chuzenji. Board a solo SUP or a five-meter (16-foot) megaboard for an early-evening paddle as the sun dips and gives way to the quiet stillness of twilight. Weather willing, there'll be a canvas of color in the western sky before the moon rises.

Solo and group paddleboards and different sizes of inflatable rafts are used, depending on the day.

Chanokidaira Nature Hike

Duration

2 hours



Enjoy a light hike to the 1,600-meter (5,250-foot) Chanokidaira lookout point in the hills behind the hotel. The forested trail offers beautiful views of Lake Chuzenji, and seasonal highlights include the rhododendrons in spring, the fresh leaf canopy of summer, and the colorful foliage each fall. Your reward is a spectacular view of Mount Nantai.

OkuNikko History Ride

Duration

2 hours



The history of the Lake Chuzenji area dates back more than 1,200 years to the founding of Chuzenji Temple and the times when these hills were first explored by devotees of mountain worship. From the late 19th century, many diplomats kept their holiday homes here. Cycle back to the roots of OkuNikko with visits to Chuzenji Temple and the former villas of the British and Italian embassies.

Hangetsuyama Cycling

Duration

2 hours

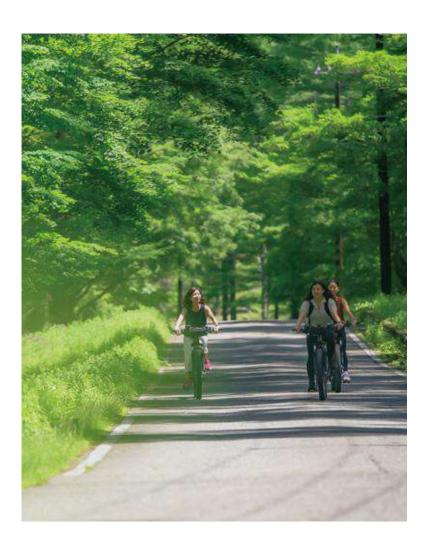


Hop on a mountain bike to ride the Lake Chuzenji Skyline, considered one of the best roads in Japan for scenic touring. Our destination is the Hangetsuyama observation deck, where you will have a panoramic view of the OkuNikko highlands. The route back is a downhill ride with gorgeous views of the Nikko mountain range.

Duration

2.5 hours

Cycle'n Cruise (Mountain bike & speedboat)



Put a new spin on your memories of the scenic OkuNikko highlands two ways. First, take a mountain-bike ride through the oak and larch forest of Odashirogahara. Next, board a speedboat to cruise back to the hotel on Lake Chuzenji with up-front views of Hatcho Dejima and Mount Nantai. Each season offers its own special beauty.



OkuNikko Nature Walk

Duration

2.5 hours



Well maintained footpaths and few ups and downs make it easy for even casual hikers to enjoy the pristine watershed of the Lake Yuno area and the marshy grasslands of Senjogahara, both Ramsar sites that are highly valued for their unique ecology. Enjoy a delightful walk in these protected lands with their plentiful birds and waterfowl, gurgling streams, mossy fallen trees, and majestic views of Mount Nantai.

3.5 hours

Shugendo Experience





Encounter Shugendo, an ascetic religious tradition that draws on Taoist, Buddhist and Shinto beliefs. First, purify yourself with incense, then hike to three secluded waterfalls of the Kirifuri highlands. Try the centuries-old *takigyo* practice of standing beneath a cascade to purify the body-mind, and come away refreshed by the spiritual energy of the mountain.

Fly-Fishing

Duration

4 hours



OkuNikko is sacred ground to aficionados of recreational fly-fishing in Japan. The sport originated here in 1902, when the Scottish merchant Thomas Glover released brook trout in Lake Yuno and the Yukawa River. If you are new to fly-fishing, what better place to give it a try than right here where it began? All gear is provided and a seasoned guide will assist you.

This offer is limited to fishing season.

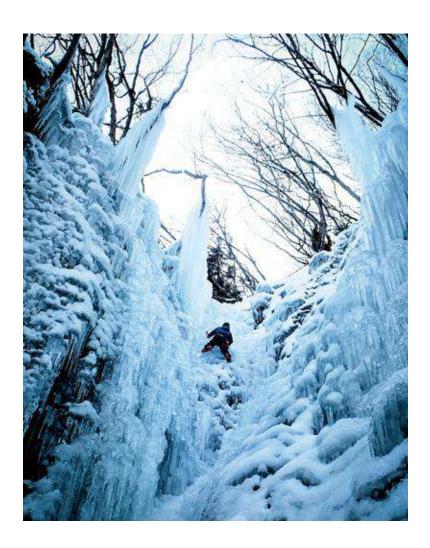


Winter Activities



5.5 hours

Ice-Climbing Experience





Gear up with crampons and a helmet and scale the 25-meter (82-foot) ice wall adjacent to Choji no Taki, one of three secluded waterfalls of the Kirifuri highlands. A guaranteed adrenaline rush, this thrilling winter sport is for the true adventure seeker. Feel the raw power of nature all around you, amid the sparkling beauty.

4.5 hours

Woodland Snowshoe Hike

OkuNikko is one of the few areas in the Kanto region where you can enjoy powder snow. Strap on a pair of snowshoes and trek with a guide through the quiet hush of sparkling woodlands. If you wish, along the way you can glide down pristine slopes on an inflatable bodyboard.





2-4.5 hours

Snow Cycling



Fat bikes give the extra stability and suspension needed to ride on snow, and are a great way to take in the crisp air of the Odashirogahara forest in the winter season when all is hush and still. Add-ons to this fun cycling experience include a snowshoe hike and a deeper trek all the way to lori Falls. When the cascade freezes over in the deep months of winter it's a memorable sight to behold.

Ritz Kids



45 or 90 minutes



Under the watchful eyes of our Ladies and Gentlemen, Ritz Kids are invited on a mission to explore the hotel in a fun and educational way, seeking out one of Nikko's famed monkeys with the aid of a treasure map. Caretakers, meanwhile, can use the same time to unwind over a relaxed dinner.
