To finish? The Matcha tea ceremony at Kabuki presents a serene choreographed presentation of this ancient culinary past-time.

For a traditional affair the resort's Club Lounge presents a comforting spread of cucumber sandwiches, and scones piled high with clotted cream and mouth-watering fruit jams. Enjoy from the 10th floor balcony with panoramic ocean garden views and lashings of tea. For those after a grand slam Champagne and candy-coloured macaroons are available on tap!
