Recreation Activities

Purisima Creek Redwood Preserve

**LOCATION: Half Moon Bay, CA**

Approximately 7 miles from the hotel, a 15 minute drive.

COST: \$80 per person**EVENT 1 to 2 hours**

DURATION: Redwood walks can be customized to fit the group's time frame. Light walks to strenuous hikes can be arranged.

DESCRIPTION:

This preserve is located on the western slopes of the Santa Cruz Mountains overlooking Half Moon Bay. The centerpiece of this 4,711-acre preserve is Purisima Creek Canyon, home to towering redwoods. The preserve includes 24 miles of developed trails and historical logging roads, which provide opportunities for easy walks or long, strenuous hikes or anything in between. Guests can enjoy a quick glimpse of the magnificent Coastal Redwoods or take a full day to hike to the top of the preserve with views of the Pacific Ocean on a loop trail.

DETAILS:

Hikes can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Shopping excursions at the small boutiques and galleries on Main Street in Half Moon Bay can be included.
- Hike can be combined with other activities such as: Año Nuevo Hike, Pescadero Marsh Natural Preserve, Harley Farms Goat Dairy, and Pigeon Point Lighthouse.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Mavericks & Pillar Point Bluff Hike

**LOCATION: Half Moon Bay, CA**

Approximately 10.5 miles from the hotel, a 15 to 20 minute drive.

COST: **\$80 per person**

EVENT **1 to 2 hours**

DURATION: The hike is easy to moderate.

DESCRIPTION:

Pillar Point Bluff offers some of the most majestic ocean views in Half Moon Bay. Sheer cliffs tower over white sands and the rocky reefs of the southern fringe of the Fitzgerald Marine Reserve below. Atop the bluff, enjoy an array of coastal scrub and spring time wildflowers, making homes for unique coastal wildlife. Hovering birdlife can be seen including: Red-Tailed Hawks, Brown Pelicans, American Kestrels, and White-Tailed Kites.

In the winter months, keep your gaze toward the waves, you may get a chance to see the world famous Mavericks big wave surf spot breaking. These powerful waves can sometimes reach heights of up to 60 feet and challenge some of the best big wave surfers in the world during the annual Titans of Maverick's surf contest.

DETAILS:

- Hikes can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Shopping excursions at the small boutiques and galleries on Main Street in Half Moon Bay can be included.
- Hike can be combined with other activities such as: Año Nuevo Hike, Pescadero Marsh Natural Preserve, Harley Farms Goat Dairy, and Pigeon Point Lighthouse.

Montara Mountain Hike

**LOCATION: Montara, CA**

Approximately 12 miles from the hotel, a 20 minute drive.

COST: \$80 per person**EVENT 1 to 2 hours**

DURATION: Based on length of the hike, the difficulty level is moderate to challenging.

DESCRIPTION:

With an elevation of more than 1,800 feet, on a clear day it feels as if you can see forever. On a foggy day, guests will literally be above the clouds. With crashing waves of the Pacific Ocean just at the foot of Montara Mountain, this is definitely the place to be for sweeping views of the beautiful coast side. Allow guests four to five hours to reach the summit and complete the descent down. If short on time, the Grey Whale Cove trail is popular and offers views of the coast below with a relatively flat traverse.

DETAILS:

Hikes can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Fitzgerald Marine Reserve

**LOCATION: Moss Beach, CA**

Approximately 9 miles from the hotel, a 20 minute drive.

COST: **\$75 per person**

EVENT **1 to 2 hours**

DURATION: Best at low tide. This walk is set at a low level of difficulty.

DESCRIPTION:

This site of the current Fitzgerald Marine Reserve was originally settled by Native Americans (the Ohlone Tribe) approximately 5,800 years ago. In 1908, the Ocean Shore Railroad extended through the town of Moss Beach, effectively creating this location as a tourist destination. Remains of the foundation and some original landscape features from the Smith-Doegler home site from the early-1900s may be found on the bluffs overlooking the Reserve.

The site has long been a source of research and materials for marine biologists and collectors, so much so that, in 1969, San Mateo County urged the State of California to designate the site as a state reserve to protect the remaining flora and fauna. On August 5, 1969 the site was officially designated as a state reserve.

DETAILS:

Walks can accommodate a minimum of 8 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met. Groups larger than 10 people do require a reservation and docent. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Hike can be combined with other tours for full day excursions. Such as, Coastal Tour, Purisima Creek Redwoods, Pigeon Point Lighthouse, or Thomas Fogarty Winery.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Surfing Lessons



LOCATION: Half Moon Bay or
Pacifica, CA

Distance varies depending upon
surf location.

COST: \$150 per person

EVENT DURATION: 1 to 2 hours

DESCRIPTION:

Embrace one of California's unique pastimes by learning to surf at Pacifica's famous Linda Mar Beach or Surfer's Beach in Half Moon Bay. Instruction on surfing skills such as paddling, pop up techniques and balancing, as well as ocean safety, surfing etiquette and wave conditions will all be emphasized. Instructors will ensure everyone has a fun time and push each surfer to catch their first wave.

DETAILS:

Lessons can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. All equipment provided, including wetsuit and surfboard. Instructors are knowledgeable and CPR/First-Aid certified. All ages and skill levels welcome, must be able to swim. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Swimsuit, athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Kayaking & Paddle Boarding

**LOCATION: Pillar Point Harbor, CA**

Approximately 7.5 miles from the hotel, a 15 minute drive.

COST: **\$145 per person**

EVENT DURATION: **2 to 3 hours**

DESCRIPTION:

Kayaking or Paddle Boarding are unique ways to enjoy the natural setting of the captivating coastal region of Half Moon Bay. Glide across the waters of Pillar Point Harbor while getting close to and observing harbor seals, marine birds and other wildlife in their natural habitat. Instructors provide a basic introduction of boating, paddling and safety skills before leading guests out onto the water

DETAILS:

These activities can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests and maximum of 30 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. All equipment provided – double kayaks or paddle boards, paddles, life-vests, and water-skirts. Instructors are knowledgeable and CPR/First-Aid certified. All skill levels welcome, must be able to swim. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Water shoes, or sandals and a warm jacket are recommended. Extra clothes should be brought along in case guests get wet.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Paddle board activities are offered at this location and can be substituted for kayaking.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Horseback Riding



LOCATION: Half Moon Bay, CA

Approximately 5 miles from the hotel, a 10 minute drive.

COST: \$150 per person

EVENT DURATION: 1.5 hours

Schedule for 1.5 hour ride: Monday – Friday

Start Times: 8:00am, 9:00am, 11:00am, 1:00pm, 2:30pm
3:30pm (Daylight Savings Time Only)

Schedule for 1.5 hour ride: Saturday – Sunday

Start Times: 8:00am 11:00am, 1:30pm, 2:30pm
3:30pm (Daylight Savings Time Only)

DESCRIPTION:

Experience riding a horse on the beach and be only feet from the Pacific Ocean, Sea Horse Ranch has just the ride for you. Ride along the trail that hugs the coast and offers spectacular views of not just the beach, but the California landscape and Princeton Harbor. Keep your eyes peeled for the variety of marine life frolicking in the waters, and don't forget to look up and potentially spot a red-tailed hawk hovering in place as it searches for its next meal.

RANCH RULES:

We use a Height-to-Weight Proportion Chart to determine whether or not it is safe for you to ride. Final decision will be made by the horse ranch.

DETAILS:

Tours can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests and maximum of 24 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Guest must wear long pants, which completely cover the ankles and completely enclosed shoes. No open-toed shoes or heels more than 1/2 inch. A warm jacket is recommended. Unfortunately, no personal items will be allowed on the ride.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Shopping excursions at the small boutiques and galleries on Main Street in Half Moon Bay can be included.



Full payment is due on day of event. Reservations must be cancelled 8 days prior to the event or will be charged full amount. Transportation is required at an additional charge. Pricing varies depending on availability, group size and number of stops for the outing.

Glass Blowing Classes

**LOCATION: Half Moon Bay, CA**

Approximately 5 miles from the hotel, a 10 minute drive.

COST: \$125per person

EVENT 2-4 hours depending on

DURATION: size of the group

DESCRIPTION:

Peek into a glass blowing studio to witness an artisans craft created right before your eyes. If you prefer a more hands on experience, a glass blowing class can be arranged for smaller groups. A glass pumpkin can be created as an ornamental piece that reflects on Half Moon Bay's agricultural heritage.

DETAILS:

Event can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests and maximum of 15 guests. All projects will need to cool overnight and will be picked up the following day by the Recreation Department. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants.
- Enjoy wine tasting at La Nebbia winery located adjacent to the glass blowing studio.

Half Moon Bay Coastal Tour



LOCATION: Pescadero, CA

Approximately 20 miles from the hotel a 25 to 30 minute drive.

COST: \$150 per person for 3 stops

Additional stops are \$25 per stop.

EVENT DURATION: 3 to 4 hours

DESCRIPTION:

One of our most diverse and customizable tours, this coastal experience will ensure you see the hidden gems of the coast side. Whether it's visiting historical landmarks and sweeping vista sites, or experiencing classic Northern California while wine tasting, enjoying coastal redwoods and shopping at local boutiques this tour has the ability to offer something for everyone.

TOUR STOP EXAMPLES:

- Purisima Canyon, home to the Purisima Creek Redwoods.
- Grey Whale Cove State Beach and the rugged coastline of the infamous Devil's Slide.
- Moss Beach Distillery or Fitzgerald Marine Reserve.
- Pillar Point Harbor, home to Half Moon Bay's hard working fishermen and the site of Titans of Mavericks big wave surf competition.
- Historic Main Street Half Moon Bay and shopping at the charming antique shops and boutiques.
- Pigeon Point Lighthouse, one of the tallest lighthouses in North America.
- Harley Farms Goat Dairy, meet the goats and sample freshly made goat cheeses.

Pigeon Point Lighthouse Tour

**LOCATION: Pescadero, CA**

Approximately 20 miles from the hotel a 25 to 30 minute drive.

COST: **\$75 per person**

EVENT DURATION: **1.5 hours**

DESCRIPTION:

One of the tallest lighthouses in North America, the 118-foot Pigeon Point Lighthouse has guided mariners and impressed visitors from its beginnings in 1872. Though access to the top of the lighthouse is no longer allowed due to structural damage, the grounds are just as spectacular. Visitors not only get to experience a historic structure, but also enjoy the coastal areas surrounding Pigeon Point Light Station, which are rich with wild life. Marine mammals, such as seals and whales, can be seen regularly from shore as they pass by beyond the surf.

DETAILS:

Tours can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of Half Moon Bay's many coastal restaurants or at Duarte's Tavern in Pescadero.
- Pigeon Point Lighthouse Tour can be combined with other tours such as: Purisima Creek Redwoods, Año Nuevo Hike, Pescadero Marsh Natural Preserve, Harley Farms Goat Dairy

Harley Farms Goat Dairy Tours

Harley Farms is a restored 1910 dairy, with 200 alpine goats on nine acres of pasture in Pescadero, California. The farm grew from six pet goats to today's herd, producing their delicious, critically-acclaimed cheese. This informative tour takes us from pasture, to processing, to packaging. At the end of the tour, guests will be able to design a goat cheese 'button' round to enjoy when they return home.

DETAILS:

Tours can accommodate a minimum/maximum of 20 guests. Water and snacks are provided.

Athletic shoes and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

Redwood Tree Zip Lining Tour



LOCATION: Santa Cruz, CA

Approximately 50 miles from the hotel, a 60 minute drive.

COST: \$225 per person

EVENT DURATION: 2 hours

DESCRIPTION:

Native only to Northern California and Southern Oregon, see the magnificent redwood trees up close. Imagine zip lining through the redwood canopy 150 feet off the ground. Tour takes two hours and is led by two certified guides who share ecological knowledge and bring the forest to life. With a total of six zip lines and two bridges, it is fun for everyone to enjoy.

DETAILS:

Tours can accommodate a minimum of 8 guest. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. All equipment provided – Guest must be a minimum of 10 years of age, be a minimum of 4' and 4" tall and weigh between 75-250 pounds Water and snacks are provided.

Wine Tasting Experiences

Beauregard Vineyards Tasting Experience

**LOCATION: Bonny Doon, CA**

Approximately 40 miles from the hotel, a 55 minute drive.

COST: \$100 per person

Add a cheese and fruit platter for an additional cost.

EVENT DURATION: 1 to 2.5 hours**DESCRIPTION:**

The Beauregard family has been working the land in Bonny Doon, CA growing premium wine grapes since 1945. Four generations later, the estate's vines now span 63 acres of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon and Zinfandel. As winemakers, it is their mission to produce wines that display the flavor of the land and make wines that are true to their variety. The wines are simplistic in the sense that they reflect what they truly are. This is accomplished through old world winemaking techniques.

DETAILS:

The tastings can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

A palate for great wines and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Lunch stops can be arranged at one of many coastal restaurants from Half Moon Bay to Santa Cruz.
- Include a second winery stop at Thomas Fogarty Winery or La Nebbia Winery.

Thomas Fogarty Winery Tasting Experience

**LOCATION: Woodside, CA**

Approximately 26 miles from the hotel, a 45 minute drive.

COST: **Pricing varies based on availability at the winery.**
Add a cheese and fruit platter for an additional cost.

EVENT DURATION: **1 to 2.5 hours**

DESCRIPTION:

Twenty-five acres of Burgundian-style varietals are planted on this 325-acre estate, focusing on Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and small lots of Merlot and Sangiovese. The winery sits on Skyline Boulevard at a 2,000-foot elevation. The long, cool, growing season and excellent sun exposure provide an ideal climate for these grape varieties. Dr. Fogarty's vision is to produce high quality, character-filled wines, which take full advantage of the unique soil and climate of this appellation. Enjoy wine-tasting at its finest at Thomas Fogarty Winery. The winery also has great views across Silicon Valley and even the city of San Francisco on a clear day.

DETAILS:

The tastings can accommodate a minimum of 10 guests. Additional costs may be incurred if minimums are not met and no guarantees are made for groups exceeding this limit. Water and snacks are provided.

WHAT TO BRING:

A palate for great wines and a warm jacket are recommended.

MODIFICATIONS/ADDITIONS:

- Include a second winery stop, La Nebbia Winery located in Half Moon Bay or Beauregard Vineyards.

La Nebbia Winery Tasting Experience

EVENT DURATION: 1 to 2.5 hours**DESCRIPTION:**

La Nebbia Winery produces big hearty red wines and newer wines, Reisling, Sauvignon Blanc, Sangiovese, and Sparkling. Vintner Kendyl Kellogg has returned the winery to its roots; producing complex, full-bodied red wines. Enjoy the vineyard's bocce ball courts or peek into Half Moon Bay Glass Blowing studio to witness an artisans craft created right before your eyes.

Golden Gate Bridge Walk

**LOCATION: San Francisco, CA**

\$660 million: The cost in US dollars of earthquake-retrofitting the bridge, which began in 1997 and is projected to be finished in 2017 at the earliest.

\$35 million: The cost to build the bridge.

746: Height, in feet, of the Golden Gate Bridge's towers. They may appear even taller because they're tapered.

9: The Golden Gate Bridge's current ranking on the list of the world's longest suspension bridges.



There are only two other known mating ground locations along the Pacific Ocean coastline. Peak season for Elephant Seal viewing is from mid-December through the end of March. A State Park docent accompanies groups during the high season and offers valuable insight as well as guidance.

Molting Season: April 1 – August 31

Northern elephant seals come ashore during the spring and summer months to shed their outer layer of skin and fur.

Fall Haul Out Season: September 1 – November 30

By summer's end, most elephant seals have returned to sea to feed. Small numbers of one to three year old juveniles haul out on remote beaches as part of their early development.

Natural Preserve Closed: December 1-14

Pregnant females and adult males begin to arrive on the beaches and form harems. Visitor access is closed during this period.

Breeding Season and Walks: December 15 – March 31

Northern elephant seals come ashore to give birth and mate from early December through March. Bull seals engage in battles for breeding access to the females from early December through January.
