Designed by Hirsch Bedner Associates, these enhancements offer a modernized and refreshed version of the existing Bacara resort – which joined The Ritz-Carlton portfolio in September 2017 – while maintaining its iconic charm. Lobby and Guest Reception

The old-world elegance of the lobby is preserved with thoughtfully curated furnishings forged from natural materials featuring organic textures and soothing tones. Metallic accents and smooth surfaces complement bespoke wooden, leather, and stone detailing throughout, modernizing the space. Perfectly blending the old with the new is a custom-made glass chandelier sparkling in the atrium above. Upon checking in at the new guest reception desk – hand-carved from Italian marble on-site by stone masons, flown in from Italy – visitors will look up to discover specially commissioned artwork with undulating curves and a series of custom photographs and paintings depicting the rugged cliffs and picturesque shoreline of Santa Barbara. Handmade by Artist Niki Zarrabi, the installation captivates with its soothing palette of serene neutral tones and polished bronze accents glimmering in the dramatic lighting.

Bacara Bar and Ocean Terrace

Masterfully designed to offer guests an elevated experience, Bacara Bar flows seamlessly out onto Ocean Terrace which now boasts awe-inspiring unobstructed views of the shoreline below. A nod to the region's history of basket weaving, locals and guests alike can admire a woven sculpture situated directly above the circular bar. A new wall of pivoting doors leading to Ocean Terrace further emphasizes the indoor-outdoor experience where guests will find an array of plush seating, warm fire tables, and a large firepit to gather around on cool California evenings. Set against the backdrop of the enchanting Pacific Ocean, Bacara Bar and Ocean Terrace offer the ideal setting for friends and families to create lasting memories.

The Ritz-Carlton Spa and Fitness Center

Reinvented with a soft palette to exude wellness and tranquility throughout, the expansive 42,000 square-foot Ritz-Carlton Spa draws inspiration from the sandy beaches and majestic Pacific Ocean. Designed to immediately soothe visitors with the sound of gently bubbling water, the new entryway features a calming fountain which is met by a floor-to-ceiling pendant light, resembling a water drop, stretching down from above. Guided by a stone path, guests arrive at the reclaimed wooden reception desk to discover a one-of-a-kind work of modern art handmade by Emily Mann. The piece reflects hues of gray, blue, and silver, reminiscent of sea water gathering in a tide pool. Large billowing sheers soften the walls of the spa lobby and encourage relaxation in the serenity lounges, which have also been fully transformed. Cascading sheer pods are positioned along the radius of the lounge wall, allowing the guests the flexibility of privacy or group interaction. A cluster of plush seating is positioned in front of the cozy fireplace and flanked by soft sheers at the window perimeter. This wellness building also boasts a revitalized fitness space with open ceilings and crisp white walls complemented by warm wood tones and energizing murals. New hardwood floors, a luxurious refreshment area, and top-of-the-line strength equipment and weights are among the updates. The space has also been expanded to include an outdoor terrace featuring an outdoor multi-station gym and special flooring for al fresco movement and stretching.

Function Spaces

Refreshed with rich earth tones, warm wood elements, large cascading sheers, and contemporary lighting throughout, the resort offers seven modernized indoor meeting and event spaces. From small groups of 20 guests in the salon rooms to grand affairs for up to 1,050 guests in Bacara Ballroom, The Ritz-Carlton Bacara, Santa Barbara provides the ideal venue for conferences, board meetings, galas, film screenings, weddings and more. For guests who wish to enjoy the fresh ocean air, the coastal resort boasts three spacious outdoor venues.

The Ritz-Carlton Club® Lounge

A signature Ritz-Carlton amenity, the brand-new Ritz-Carlton Club[®] Lounge has arrived at The Ritz-Carlton Bacara, Santa Barbara. Offering guests a higher caliber of luxury, the villa-style Club Lounge with an expansive outdoor terrace features a bright and fresh design aesthetic with natural elements of the coast coming to life via soft neutrals and hues of blue. A combination of natural textures, clean surfaces, and traditional design touches permeate throughout, offering an inviting yet modern environment that mirrors the rest of the resort. One of the only stand-alone Club Lounges in The Ritz-Carlton portfolio, the luxurious space offers amenities such as a WMF Coffee Machine, two WineStation[®] machines, executive kitchen, and more. Guests of The Club Lounge can also enjoy a unique and rare opportunity to experience an exhibit featuring the works of John Nava, Hank Pitcher, Phoebe Brunner and Nicole Strasburg. On loan from Sullivan Goss — An American Gallery, the exclusive collection features oil paintings that highlight the beautiful California Coast. All four artists have resided in Santa Barbara and draw inspiration from the beautiful surroundings of the region.

Designed to inspire children, young adults, and families, Cousteau-trained naturalists guide participants as they learn about and experience kelp forests, a diversity of birds, the intertidal, and the Chumash culture – Native American people who historically inhabited Central and Southern California – through memorable adventures and hands-on activities.
