

## Types of Hand Sewing Needles



As a guide, always remember the general rule of the bigger the number, the finer the needle. | \*Not Actual Sizes Shown.

#### Darners

- Good general purpose needles.
- Long eye, easy to use with multiple threads.

#### Long Darners

- Good for mending, basting and layering fabrics together.
- Use for hand tacking & applying trims.

#### Easy Threading

- Calyx (open) eye allows easiest threading of eye.
- Second eye can be used as a regular eye.

#### Sharps

- Great for general sewing.
- Suitable for light & medium fabrics.
- Our shortest needles with very small eye.

#### Crewel / Embroidery

- Long, wide eye for easy threading, accommodates larger or multi-strand thread.
- Suitable for general sewing.

#### Mattress

• Good for button replacement, button tufting or sewing.

#### Double Point

- Double point allows continuous sewing without turning needle over.
- Attach springs to webbing, stuffing to burlap and buttons to upholstered items.

#### Bolster

• Long length allows easy attachment of buttons to the ends of bolsters or other deep cushions.

#### **Curved Quilting**

- Great for difficult to reach tasks.
- Curvature allows for sewing next to hard objects.

#### **Curved Upholstery**

- Use for sewing springs to frame, closing cushions and chair backs, attaching Welt Cord and more.
- Fits shape of hand, reduces hand fatigue and increases stitching speed.

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### Types of Sewing Machine Needles

Machine needle sizes are always quoted in imperial and metric. | \*Not Actual Sizes Shown.

- 10/70 | Suitable for light fabrics, silk and taffeta.
- 11/75 or 12/80 | Suitable for medium fabrics, cotton, linen and satin.
- 14/90 | Suitable for medium to heavy fabrics. Ideal in-between needle.
- 16/100 | Suitable for heavy fabrics, denim, tweeds, drapery and upholstery weight fabrics.

#### **Regular Point**

- Straight, use for basic stitching.
- Variety of lengths & shank thicknesses available.

#### Tri-Point

• Use on leather and heavy vinyls. 16/135/#21

#### **Ball Point**

- Ideal for use on jersey, stretch and synthetic fabrics.
- Variety of lengths & shank thicknesses available.

#### **Blind Stitch**

• Curved needle. Short or long options in various sizes.
